You will repair or alter one or two items that you brought with you.

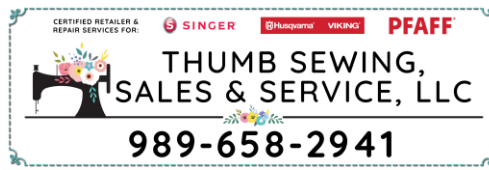

- Thread to match the items(s) you will be repairing.
