I find some good, loyal, law-abiding sportsmen from Los Angeles county, but you can take it from me there is a lot of game hogs from there cleaning up our game. I can't be every place at once. There is a state law that doesn't allow the San Diego county supervisors to pay more than \$95 a month for a county game warden.
