

# California Southern RAIL ROAD.

**All Rail Line to and from National City and San Diego to points East, and close connections made at Colton with Trains to and from San Francisco and Los Angeles.**

**ON AND AFTER MONDAY, OCTOBER 1st, 1903,** trains of the California Southern Rail Road, carrying the U. S. Mails and Wells-Fargo's Express, will leave National City daily, (except Sundays), at 6 A. M., San Diego, 6:14, D Street, 6:40, Oldtown, 6:54, Schwyn, 7:12, Cordero, 7:53, Encinitas, 8:34, Stewart's, 8:53, Frazier's, 9:33, San Luis Rey, 9:19, Ysidora, 9:37, De Luz, 10:05, Fallbrook, arriving 10:22, leaving 10:47, 70-Mile Siding, 11:04, Temecula, 11:36, Laguna, 12:25 P. M., Pinesdale, arriving 1:04, leaving 1:06, San Jacinto, 1:47, Riverside, 2:22, Colton, arriving 2:42, leaving 3:10, arriving at San Bernardino at 3:25.

Going South, trains will leave San Bernardino at 10:40, A. M., Colton, arriving 10:55, leaving 11:15, Riverside, 11:35, San Jacinto, 12:05 P. M., Pinesdale, arriving 1:01, leaving 1:05, Laguna, 1:44, Temecula 2:23, 70-Mile Siding, 3:10, Fallbrook arriving 3:30, leaving 3:35, De Luz, 4:07, Ysidora, 4:33, San Luis Rey 4:47, Frazier's, 4:54, Stewart's, 5:07, Encinitas, 5:22, Cordero, 5:53, Schwyn, 6:33, Oldtown, 7:05, D Street, 7:15, San Diego, 7:31, National City, 7:45. The above is National City time, which is 25 minutes faster than San Francisco time.

Passengers will save from ten (10) to sixty (60) cents by purchasing their tickets of the Agent before entering the cars. Round trip tickets cannot be purchased on the train; they are sold only at stations where there is an Agent.
