## **Conquest Valley Motorsport**

## Recreational Activity RULES. June 2022.

- » If you attend an event run by Conquest Valley Motorsport all the rules below must be adhered to at ALL times.
- » Any non-rider guests including Mechanics, friends, family members, children, animals and any other member of the public on site must stay in the designated areas and when moving around the site only use the designated paths.
- » All riders must sign on and read and understand the disclaimer and rules prior to entering the course or starting their bike.
- » Only riders who have signed on and passed scrutineering and safety checks may ride. All other people including mechanics, friends, or family members who have not signed on or paid to ride, may not ride nor enter the track.
- Any intentional take outs of riders or extremely rough riding will not be tolerated.
  Such actions will result in a safe removal from the track and a suspension.
- » This is a non-competitive recreational activity, as such no bullying, bad sportsmanship, aggressive or otherwise intimidating behaviour will be tolerated.
- » Five(5) M.P.H. in pit and paddock areas (Walking speed only).
- » There is to be no reckless behaviour within the paddocks such as wheelies or other endangering behaviour.
- » Riders and Bikes MUST have the scrutineer check both the bike and equipment prior to entry onto the track.
- » Riders must enter and exit tracks at the marshalled gates and follow instructions precisely during this process.
- » Riders must adhere to the instructions of event personnel and medics at all times.
- » Parents/Guardians are required to monitor their children and ensure they understand these rules. You will be responsible for your Childs behaviour and you must accompany your child at all times whilst not on the track.
- Machines must be safe and in a fit state of use including but not limited to the areas outline below
  All panels must be securely fixed to the proposed vehicle
  All levers must be devoid of sharp pointy edges to remove impalement risk.
  The bikes must have working brakes
  Bike must not create an environmental hazard such as leaking OIL, fuel or other fluids

whilst in use nor be a fire hazard.

All silencers must meet FIM regulations of 96dB.

The Bike must be of appropriate size and power for the proposed level of activities.

- » All riders are required to refuel in designated area.
- All Equipment must be in adequate useable condition for the proposed activities
  Helmets must be ACU approved, intact and fit for purpose.

Boots must immobilise the ankle and be of appropriate design as to protect the ankle and lower legs.

We recommend wearing eye protection in the form of shatter resistant motocross goggles. TEAR OFFS ARE PROHIBITED

We recommend body armour to be worn protecting a minimum of the riders chest and spine.

We also recommend adequate protective gloves to be worn as to give a minimum level of protection for the hands.

The use of neck braces, knee braces/supports, elbow pads/braces or any or

supplementary PPE is not mandatory but is recommended.

- » Event Wrist bands must be worn on the wrist and be visible for checking as riders enter the track.
- » Bike scrutineering stickers will be applied to the bike and be visible for verification of scrutineering as bikes enter the track.
- » If you are a slower rider with someone trying to pass you, you are required to let them pass on the right hand side in a safer manner.
- » It is the riders own responsibility to avoid collisions with other riders. You will avoid this through due diligence and riding within your own skill and ability, in the event of contact with other riders leading to injury or damage to property due to not following this rule you will accept the liability.
- » The first lap on the course is identified as a sighting lap. Use this lap to familiarise yourself with the course.
- » Use of alcohol or controlled substances is prohibited by riders. Suspicion of use of these substances will result in an immediate ejection and possible suspension.
- » There is a NO TOLERANCE with fighting between riders. Both riders will be ejected, and a suspension will result. In the event of a disagreement or feeling of wrong doing happening. Seek out a staff member and inform the event staff.
- » Conquest Valley Motorsport is fully insured but we offer no personal insurance of any kind, you must be satisfied that the course is suitable for you to ride, If you feel that the course is not satisfactory for you at any time then please do not ride the course.
- » At no time shall any rider, mechanic, friend or family member verbally abuse, or threaten any event staff or anyone onsite. The offending person will be ejected immediately. There is a zero tolerance policy on threatening, or verbally abusing staff members.
- » Dogs to be kept under control at all times.
- » One direction of travel around the course.
- » No camp fires
- » No Illegal drugs or alcohol to be consumed/used on site.
- » No washing facilities will be provided
- » Do no enter the farm yards or buildings these are private property and nothing to do with our events.
