

MINI NEWBORN

This is a shortened session 1-1.5hrs max. Baby only however can add on one parent shot for \$50.00. You will get an array of shots however we shorten up to one neutral table posing fabric, then limit to one background-basket or bucket variation with a couple changes of layers thrown in the mix. I guarantee a minimum of 15 finished files however expect anywhere from 15-50 as I do not limit what we end up with!

Included in every package is a 6 month downloadable, shareable, shoppable, private gallery.

You can choose your tone of backdrop. If you want to go grey background or creamy neutrals. We all have preferences and depending on what our house decor may be, I tell people imagine it hanging on your wall. I tend to layer in different shades of neutrals and then mix in a little touch of whatever it is you like to go for, add that little pop of color. Textures seem to add a lot to a photo.

Clothing I suggest to keep things neutral, and if you have other children to add to the pictures then add that color into their wardrobe and we will pull a little something out of the wraps I have or something that catches your eye. You are more than welcome to bring any outfits you want if that is your preference. Dress in layers it gets about 75-76 degrees in the studio!

Expect the full session to take at least 2-3 hours depending on baby. If they want to feed a lot then we stop and feed between changing wraps or background choices or whatever works. Do not have any specific expectations as sometimes we end up with whatever they allow us to do.

Bring an extra change of clothes incase we get brave and try a little nude baby holding, I expect baby to pee on things or have little accidents so don't panic. Bring lots of wipes you prefer, diapers and food for baby. Bring yourself a water bottle however I keep some at the studio, Most of all bring a fun laid back attitude and relax!

I encourage people to come in and see what I have for backgrounds and if they want to take a look at what I have for fabric, backgrounds and props beforehand.

I encourage you to try to exfoliate baby as best as you can for removing dry flakes, use lots of baby lotion or oil day of shoot this cuts down on time spent editing this out. This is what takes me SO much time.





When to Book ...

We will book a tentative week to watch for but it is just to give me an idea as far as due date. To get the best squishy, relaxed flexible baby poses it is best to try to get you in between 5-15 days after baby comes. I do not guarantee certain poses of course some babies have a slight preference to positions sometimes and do not either like being wrapped or do not like being on their tummy etc. So you just have to trust me and that we will figure it out as we go. We will get lots of great shots and I am always excited to see you! This just makes my heart so full when I am done and cannot wait to deliver the first couple sneaks. I usually will take anywhere from 2-4 weeks from shoot to delivery. This all depends on time of year and how my other job affects the timeline. Please be patient!
