At the top of this page, you'll see the koine Greek words which mean Times and Seasons. This is what I decided to call my newsletter pieces when I first arrived as your pastor in October 2012. The first word, chronos, means "clock time", that type of time which means so much to us as we live our day-to-day lives. The second word, kairos, means "appointed or proper time" or "season". This is "God time" This is a reminder to me, and all of us, that some things happen on our time, but for other things we have to wait for God's time.

Twelve plus years of clock time (chronos) have wound down. If I were to say all that I have within me to say, we'd have to get the book rate in order to mail out the newsletter. I cannot begin to express the love we have for you, the appreciation for all you've done for us and for the church, and the depth of how much we will miss you.

Yet it is now the proper season (kairos) for us all to move on.

One of my first Sundays here, I preached from Hebrews 10:21-25, and noted how closely the biblical author mirrored the FISH! philosophy. Just as a reminder, the FISH! Philosophy is four simple keys used to create a great work culture and environment: Be there. Play. Make their day. Choose your attitude.

The sermon focused mostly on the first two keys, "be there" and "play". But in my last newsletter article as your pastor, I would like to focus on the last two: "Make their day" and "choose your attitude."

You all have not only "made my day", you have "made my" entire twelve-plus years here. Being able to do the work of ministry in this congregation has been an amazing experience. This has been a time of tremendous growth for me, and your support and nurture have been outstanding. If, twelve years ago, I would have had the opportunity to design the perfect congregation, I wouldn't have been able to come up with something better than who you already are. Thank you.

Finally, "Choose your attitude." I have seen you choose your attitude. You have chosen the attitude of supporting a new seminary graduate in this role as your pastor, investing in my future rather than seeking

someone "safer", with more experience. I am deeply grateful.

You have also chosen the attitude of staying together and tackling those hard questions, those difficult

financial issues, not shying away, but going forward as a community, investing in one another.

Which almost brings me back to the first point of the FISH! Philosophy, "be there." You have been there for one another. You have been there for Liza and me. And we, though we will be far away, will continue to be spiritually with you.

And I can't close without visiting again the second point of the FISH! Philosophy, "Play." This is a sacred space and a sacred community. But God created us with a wonderful sense of humor, which God shares (I mean, look who God called into ministry at age 50? God has a terrific sense of humor!) God doesn't want carbon copies of a generic "perfect Christian." God wants us to be the best you and the best me that we can be. And to praise God with all of our gifts, including our senses of humor.

I don't know about you, but that almost makes me want to go out and play.

May God bless you richly in this time of transition.




