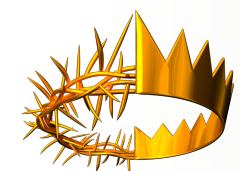


# STEP 4: THE STEWARDSHIP COVENANT

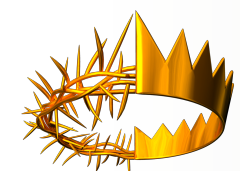
Read this aloud, then sign below.
