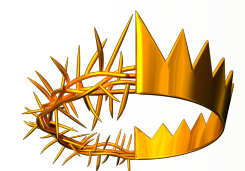

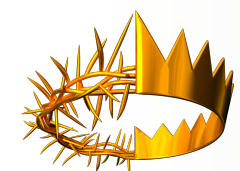

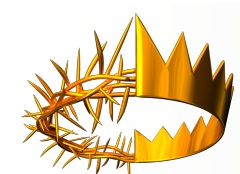
1. THE "WHIRLPOOL" CHECK-IN



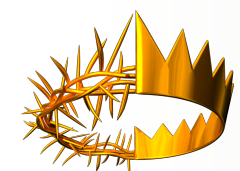
Look at the list of global crises mentioned in today's session (Pandemic, War, Economic shifts, Loss of trust).

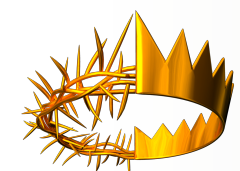

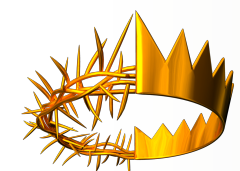
THE DOLL VS. THE WRAPPING PAPER

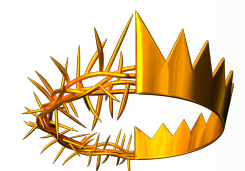

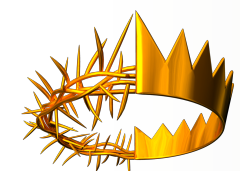

- In your current "permacrisis," what specific weakness or fear do you need to bring to the High Priest today?



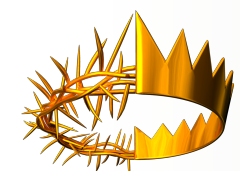

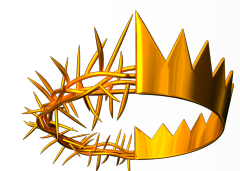
ADRENALINE FOR THE SOUL
