
Age/sunspots

Skin tags are usually a few millimetres in size and appear as a small flap of tissue that hangs off the skin by a connecting stalk. They are usually found on the neck, armpits, eyelids, groin and breasts.



Warts and verruca's

Warts are highly contagious and occur when a virus comes in contact with the skin and causes infection. Verrucae appear similar to warts but are flatter as they tend to be found on the feet. It is recommended to soak the wart or verruca for 5 minutes every day, followed by exfoliating, for one week prior to a cryopen appointment.
