

Julia Ross was born to a family of artists, painters, poets and sculptors, my happiest memories involve creative works of art. Inspired to build a career in the arts, I studied Fine Arts at University of Texas, ventured into advertising to build digital brands online. I ran a traditional advertising agency in my 20's, then began digital advertising agency in my 30's and embraced the creative aspects of the business to expand my artwork from traditional mediums to experiment with encaustic and mixed media.

Julia Ross works with art mediums of encaustic and acrylic, gouache and mixed media on large canvas, canvas board and acrylic board. Fine Art Paintings and Sculptures include encaustic, acrylic, gouache, resin and metallic elements.



Christina Lynn Fitch has been featured in private collections throughout the United States for her encaustic, mixed media, figurative works. Fitch has a Master of Fine Arts in painting from Savannah College of Art and Design.

Fitch's artwork explores events from the past, some from her own memories and others from history. Experiences captured in photographs and the memories they produce yield both despair and joy. Life can be defined by memories and how they are processed.



Randy Padorr-Black has received more than 400 awards for design and illustration over the years and have decided to pursue a less ephemeral expression of his creativity through traditional art making. Creating mostly pieces whose value as a method of communication expired after a couple of weeks in the commercial world, his collage and painting is his real passion, infinitely more fulfilling and carries greater meaning over time. Appearing in several gallery shows in the Dallas-Fort Worth area, he's encouraged that his decision to pursue fine art has been the right one.

He has appeared in galleris and exhibition shows including Artspace 111, Gallery 440, Mary Tomas Gallery, Frisco Arts Gallery, and The Other Art Fair.

Additionally, Randy taught college as an adjunct for 20 years at Marywood College, Southwestern Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences, Brookhaven College, Texas Christian University and University of Texas at Arlington. He has a BFA in Communication Arts.



Gerald Bell has been creating art all of his life, evolving from folk art to abstracts to his current fascination and love of both pop and shock art. Bell struggles with Aspergers, leaving him often struggling with other people's subtle cues and expressions. He states that he "has trouble reading between the lines" and has a fascination for human interactions and how people respond. Human complacency frustrates him while the interactions tires, compels and fascinates him. He does find it easier to understand people's genuine, sincere joy and appreciation.

He has been in numerous solo and group exhibitions in Dallas and Fort Worth, including Gallery 440, 500X Gallery, Main Street Art Fair, The Other Art Fair, Fwartfair, Arts Fort Worth, Daisha Board Gallery, Mckinney Chamber Foundation and others.







