Hudson Westbrook is a Texas singer-songwriter who was in relative obscurity until the later half of 2024, when his music began to gain significant traction. Growing up steeped in the influences of '90s country icons like George Strait, his sound blends classic sentiments with a modern edge. He first began releasing music in April 2024 and quickly made a name for himself, catapulting into the spotlight with a viral hit.

ballad, Seven Minutes In Heaven, for her latest project. Splitting his time between the iconic Bluebird Cafe and venues right here in the Metro East, Matt's soulful storytelling is quickly turning heads on Music Row. Keep this name on your radar, with a Reba cut under his belt, 2026 is poised to be his breakout year.

## Holiday Dance Floor Survival Guide

With Christmas and New Year's bringing huge crowds to venues, floor etiquette is more important than ever. Remember the "Rules of the Road":

1. **Line Dancers:** Stick to the center.
2. **Two-Steppers:** Utilize the outside lane (counter-clockwise flow).
3. **Stationary Drinkers:** Please clear the floor! The dance floor is for dancing, not for holding conversations with Santa.
