A Two-Story Honky tonk Adventure in the Heart of Bossier City – Big Country of Bossier City, Featured Venue of the Week

This week we are spotlighting Bossier City's Big Country. Bossier City's Big Country isn't just a nightclub, it's a full-blown experience. Whether you're two-stepping under neon lights or conquering the mechanical bull, this two-story country nightclub delivers high-energy fun with a Southern twist.

Why Go?

I had the chance to visit Big Country while back home visiting family in nearby Texarkana. It was my first time stepping into this local gem, and I made it a stop on my Honk Tonk Tour across the country. Let me tell you, this is not your typical country bar.

- Two-Story Layout: Upon entering, a stairwell leads to the second level that overlooks the expansive main dance floor below.
- Dance Floors: The main floor is about 1,200 sq ft and dedicated to country music and line dancing. Upstairs, a smaller 200 sq ft dance floor pumps out Top 40 hits.
- Mechanical Bull: Tucked in the corner, it's a must-try for thrill-seekers.
- Pool Tables: Both levels feature pool tables—perfect for playing while watching dancers below.
- Bars & Seating: Two full bars flank the main dance floor, with ample seating throughout. The second level also has its own bar and seating overlooking the action.

- VIP Longhorn Lounge: A cozy corner on the lower level with plush seating, ideal for private parties.

What to Expect

- **Dance styles:** Two-step, country swing, partner dancing, and line routines fit comfortably on the floor.
- **Music:** The DJ plays classic country, two-step, and line dancing songs downstairs. The DJ-driven music upstairs plays modern dance, top 40, and party music.
- **Room:** A large dance floor downstairs dedicated to country music, line dancing, and two-stepping. Free line dancing lessons are offered on Friday nights. **Upstairs:** A separate area with a DJ playing Top 40 and other popular dance hits.
- **Grab a bite:** The **Big Country Grill** is a full-service restaurant located within the venue, offering local food and appetizers.
- **Cover charge:** A cover charge is often in effect. However, ladies get in free before midnight on Thursdays and Fridays.
- **Dress code:** While the dress code is casual, some general restrictions apply. For men, sleeveless shirts are not allowed, and the club prohibits offensive, vulgar, baggy, or gym attire for all patrons. The venue also restricts "flying colors," which typically refers to gang colors.
- **Check social media:** The club often posts about weekly specials, drink deals, and events on its Instagram and Threads accounts.

My favorite moment

Dancing on the main floor while watching the crowd from above was surreal. The energy was electric, and the mix of country charm with modern flair made it unforgettable. Playing pool upstairs while the dancers twirled below added a whole new vibe to the night.

Insider tips

- Arrive early on weekends to avoid long lines
- Book the VIP lounge for special occasions—it's worth it
- Don't skip the line dancing lessons, even if you're a beginner
- The bull gets tougher as the night goes on—ride early!


