# Honky-Tonks Rising?: Keeping Boots Stompin' After Diamond Music Hall

## Featured Venue of the Week



### *Main Street Honky Tonk, Saint Charles, MO*

#### **How Main Street Honky Tonk and a Network of Local Venues Are Holding the Line (Dance) for the Saint Louis Country Community.**

When Diamond Music Hall closed on October 31st, the St. Louis–area country-dance community lost the one big room and two large, dedicated dance floors that held everyone at once. The response has been immediate and energetic: a cluster of local venues have stepped up with regular line-dance nights and lessons to keep boots stompin’ and the scene moving. This week’s feature highlights Main Street Honky Tonk in St. Charles as our focal point while mapping the practical details for the other venues now hosting line dancing.

#### **Why Go?**

Main Street Honky Tonk has become a reliable midweek hub for country music and line dancing in the St. Charles corridor. It’s a no-cover, no-frills hang where the music, the social crowd, and the dance energy are the draw.

## What to Expect

- Night: Thursdays — billed as “All new line dancing Thursdays.”
- Music: DJ Fish spins line-dance-friendly sets starting at 8:00 PM. Currently there are no formal line-dance lessons.
- Cover: No cover charge.
- Dance floor: No dedicated floor — staff move tables to clear space in front of the stage. The cleared area is hardwood and generally good for dancing, though capacity is smaller than the old Diamond ballroom.
- Crowd & vibe: Welcoming mixed-age crowd, steady locals and newcomers, upbeat and social.

## Why it matters

Main Street fills an important weekly slot with consistent music and an accessible, free-entry model. It anchors the St. Charles side of the regional network even while the overall community becomes distributed across multiple sites.

## Venues with Line Dancing — Practical Details

Several of these local venues offer weeknight line-dance nights with lessons for beginners; cover varies, and floor-size/material details are inconsistent across listings. Below are the current specifics to help you plan.

### [Silver Creek Sports & Social](#) — Belleville, IL

- Night: Tuesdays, 7:00–9:00 PM (beginner lesson 7–8, next-level 8–9).
- Cover: \$5 per person.
- Floor: Small dedicated dance floor, tile.
- Notes: Lessons for all levels.

### [MK Ranch Bar & Grill](#) — Warrenton, MO

- Night: Tuesdays — free line dancing as long as guests show up.
- Lessons: Free beginner lessons 6:00–7:00 PM; open dancing 7:00–9:00 PM.
- Cover: No cover for line dancing; venue is 21+ after 9 PM for weekend shows.
- Floor: Large venue overall (~9,200 sq ft) with a small sealed-concrete dedicated dance floor and a medium stage for bands.

### [Social Bar Soulard](#) — St. Louis, MO

- Night: Tuesdays (started Nov. 11, 2025), DJ Fish 8:00 PM–12:00 AM.
- Lessons: Free lessons, open to all skill levels.
- Cover: \$5 for 21+.

- Floor: No formal dance floor—smooth cleared concrete area.

[The Outfield Sports Bar & Grill](#) — Marthasville, MO

- Night: Wednesdays, 6:00–9:00 PM.
- Lessons: Free line-dance lessons.
- Cover: Free.
- Floor: Large checkered tile dance area in its own room (quality TBD).

[The Marquee at New Town](#) — St. Charles, MO

- Night: Wednesdays. Doors 6:00 PM; lessons 6:30–7:30 PM with Mona Frame; open dance follows.
- Cover: \$5 (21+), \$10 (18–20).
- Floor: Small mobile wood dance floor with “plenty of room” to dance when configured.

["The Office" Bar and Grill](#) — Washington, MO

- Night: 2nd & 4th Fridays, 6:00–9:00 PM (bi-monthly).
- Lessons: Free all night.
- Cover: No cover.
- Floor: Details not available.

[Warrenton Dance Hall \(Schuetzenground Dance Hall\)](#) — Warrenton, MO

- Night/Frequency: Traditional dance-hall events and scheduled two-step/line nights (check local schedule).
- Floor: One of the larger traditional wood floors in the area (better suited for larger sets).

[The Babylon](#) — O’Fallon, MO

- Launch: Line dancing begins in December (Saturday nights listed).
- Frequency: Weekly.
- Lessons/Cover: Lessons currently not listed; cover TBD (no cover expected at launch).
- Floor: Small smooth-concrete dance floor.

[Ameristar Casino – Bottleneck Blues Bar](#) — St. Charles, MO

- Launch: Line dancing to begin in January (Wednesdays).
- Frequency: Weekly.
- Cover: TBD (rumored \$10).
- Floor: Medium–large dance floor (material TBD).

## **The Complication**

A Distributed Community This patchwork of nights and rooms is both hopeful and complicated. The upside: more nights, more venues, more chances to dance and teach. The downside: no single venue currently matches Diamond Music Hall’s capacity, so the community is split across nights and locations. Expect smaller crowds per venue, more coordination for large gatherings, and opportunities for callers/instructors to build cross-venue followings.

## **How you can help keep the scene strong**

- Attend consistently—regular turnout encourages venues to expand.
- Tip bands and instructors and buy a drink or two.
- Coordinate “community nights” to bring more dancers together in larger rooms (Marquee or Schuetzenground are good candidates).
- Share event pages and invite friends—numbers matter to venue owners.

## **Final thought**

The heart of our dance community is adaptable. Main Street Honky Tonk offers a free, steady Thursday night hub in St. Charles while a constellation of neighborhood bars and halls provide varied weekly opportunities. It won’t be the same as one large room, but with consistent support and a bit of coordination, these venues can sustain— and maybe even grow—our boots-and-beats culture.

### A heartfelt shoutout to Jonny, former owner of Diamond Music Hall!!!

A huge thank you goes out to Jonny Kruse, the former owner of Diamond Music Hall in St. Peters, for his incredible contributions to the country and line dancing community. When our local dance community needed a larger space, Jonny and his team transformed their rock concert venue to welcome us.

Jonny went above and beyond by:

- **Doubling the dance space:** He added an extra dance floor, making it as large as the main floor, to accommodate all the dancers.
- **Expanding dance nights:** He originally hosted dance nights on Wednesdays and later added Fridays and select Saturdays, giving the community more opportunities to dance.
- **Hiring top talent:** He brought in the area's best country and line dance DJ, DJ Fish, and enlisted long-time dancer Mona Frame to lead lessons. The teaching team was later expanded to include Line Dance Saint Louis.
- **Hosting premier workshops:** He welcomed renowned local, national, and international choreographers to teach their famous dances at the hall.
- **Bringing live music:** He organized performances by country music artists from Nashville and the local area for the dance community to enjoy.

More than just a venue owner, Jonny gave dancers from all walks of life and all ages a place to call "home." Diamond Music Hall was a sanctuary where we could leave our fears and problems at the door, offering us peace, fun, and a space to fulfill our passion and love for music and dance.

We thank you from the bottom of our hearts, Jonny, co-owners, and the wonderful staff. We hope to see you all at other venues again.
