What can sponsorship of Blake Stevens do for you?



LOTS of "oopsies" like this happen in racing, which is why we appreciate any support you can give! This was the worst and best race day for Blake in 2022. This wreck happened on lap 3 of his Jr Honda heat race in Toledo at a regional Midwest Thunder race. Blake and team had gone to Toledo the two weekends before to pre race this track to make sure our setup was perfect. And it was perfect! Blake had already passed 3 cars in the opening laps when he came around the corner to two cars wrecking. He dove down as far as he could with a split second's notice, but clipped them with his right front, sending him air borne, and barrel rolled and finally skidded on his roof down the front stretch. The safety in these cars is top notch—he didn't even have a bruise! So much of the car was bent up he could not drive it to finish the race. Peter and other dads rushed to take the car apart and put a whole bunch of new parts on (this was a biggie, about \$800 wreck!). Blake started dead last in the lowest main, the B Main. Blake drove from last to a commanding FIRST! This put him starting 7th in the A Main Feature with some of the best junior drivers in the country. Blake avoided the wrecks and finished the race in 3rd! His first regional podium in the competitive classes. He even earned the Hard Charger award out of 180 cars present that weekend for passing the most cars and overcoming the most adversity that day. This is a day we will never forget!
