

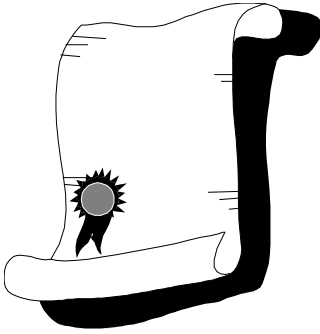

- **Two letters of recommendation** – may be from, but not limited to, teachers, principals, counselors, superintendents, church and/or community leaders and employers.
- **A brief essay** (no more than two (2) typed pages) including the following information:
 1. Your reasons for continuing your education, including the goals you wish to achieve.
 2. Your response to one (1) of the topics from below (a. or b.):
 - a. Describe a challenge in your life and how you dealt with it.
 - b. Describe any personal experiences or challenges that you believe have prepared you to succeed in college.
- **A copy of high school transcript**
