

CCEF Scholarships Decision Grid

This tool might be helpful in determining which scholarships are a good fit for you. If you have any questions, touch base with Student Services for additional guidance.

Helpful hints:

- Give yourself plenty of time to work on the scholarship applications. Letters of recommendation take time for people to complete.
- You will need to provide two (2) Letters of Recommendation for most scholarships. Only **one** letter of recommendation may be provided by a current or recent teacher or school employee. The other letter of recommendation **must be provided by a contact outside of the school district. Do not use relatives or CCEF board members.**

- Be sure to follow all directions on the application. Simple omissions or oversights can lead to your application not being selected.
- Read the information about the scholarship honoree – you may be asked questions or your impression about that individual(s) in your interview.
- Turn your completed application in a sealed envelope to Student Services (guidance office) by the deadline.
- If an interview is required, you must be present. Failure to be present for the interview will disqualify you.
- If the scholarship requirements do not specify an area of focused study, any area of study is appropriate for that scholarship.
