## IT'S HURRICANE SEASON

The 2022 Atlantic hurricane season runs from June 1 to November 30.

The National Weather Service defines a hurricane as "an intense tropical weather system with well-defined circulation and sustained winds of 74 mph (64 knots) or higher."

Hurricanes are rated according to intensity on the Saffir-Simpson Hurricane Wind Scale.

A "hurricane watch" indicates the possibility that a region could experience hurricane conditions within 48 hours.

A "hurricane warning" indicates that sustained winds of at least 74 mph are expected within 36 hours.

Prepare for a hurricane by stocking up on emergency supplies including food, water, protective clothing (extra for the little ones), medications, batteries, flashlights, important documents, cell phones and a full tank of gasoline.

## **\*\*FIREWORK SAFETY\*\***

- Obey all local laws regarding the use of fireworks.
- A responsible adult SHOULD supervise all firework activities.
- Never give fireworks to children.
- Wear safety glasses when shooting fireworks.
- Always have a bucket of water and charged water hose nearby.
- Do not experiment with homemade fireworks.
- Light one firework at a time and then quickly move away.
