BURNING WITHIN TOWN LIMITS

- 01) You are **REQUIRED** to obtain a burning permit from Town Hall. It is open from 8:00am to 5:00pm.
- 02) You are only allowed to burn vegetation that has grown on your property. You cannot burn household garbage, plastics, shingles, tiles, lumber, rubber, or anything other than plant growth that originates on your property.
- 03) You are not allowed to ignite or burn a fire after 3:00pm or on the weekend.
- 04) You are required to remain with the fire with a hose and/or proper tools to manage the fire.
- 05) You cannot burn within fifty (50) feet of any structure, unless you have an approved burner, i.e., burn barrel.
- 06) Anyone violating this ordinance could face fines of up to one-thousand and eighty-two dollars (\$1082.00) and be required to appear before the municipal judge.
