"JUNE IS NATIONAL SAFETY MONTH" SAFETY TIPS

- Have your keys to your house and car door so that it can be opened immediately.
- Never open your door to visitors unless they identify themselves.
- Leave spare keys with a trusted neighbor/friend and advise police if you are leaving town.
- Never reveal that you are home alone.
- Report any suspicious activity around your house or in the neighborhood.
- Do not give information about yourself over the phone, unless you make the call.
- Lock your car when you park or when you are driving.
- Try to park in lighted areas and near to entrance.
- Never accept a ride from a stranger.
- Lock all doors and windows every time you leave home.
- Keep a distance between flammable objects (paper, curtains, etc.) and fire sources (stove, candles, etc.)
- If your car breaks down, open the hood and stay in the vehicle. If someone offers to help, ask them to CALL for help.
- Keep poisonous substances (paint thinner, rat poison, etc.) locked up and out of reach of children.

3.106. SAME. AT-LARGE. PROHIBITED.

It shall be unlawful for any person to allow any domestic animal or fowl to run at-large on the public streets or in public places.

3.211. DOGS RUNNING AT-LARGE PROHIBITED.

No dog may run at-large beyond the premises of its owner, unless in the immediate presence of and under the control of a responsible person. Direct control may be affected by leash, or by personal command, if the latter effectively provides direct and positive control. The requirements of this section are not altered by whether a dog is vicious or uninoculated.
