#### **18.601 PARKING AND STORAGE.**

A. This article shall apply to all owners or operators of automotive vehicles, recreational vehicles or boats, herein referred to as vehicles or boats, requiring a license and not currently licensed.

B. The said owner or operators shall either:

1. Park or store their unlicensed vehicles or boats in a completely enclosed building; or
2. Pay a permit fee in such amount as approved by the Mayor and Council per vehicle or boat and parks said vehicle or boat in the back yard of a residence behind a building, fence or hedgerow of such sufficient density that the vehicle or boat will not be visible from any street adjacent to the residence; or
3. Conceal said vehicle or boat with a cover specifically designed for the purpose or protecting said vehicle or boat.

C. Any vehicle or boat deemed to be a health hazard shall have its permit revoked, and the owner shall be required to correct the hazardous condition or remove the vehicle or boat from the town as provided by Article VII of this chapter.

#### **18.602 SAME. FEE.**

A. A fee shall be required to park said unlicensed vehicle on private property. Said fee shall be payable within thirty (30) days of location of the vehicle, and renewable annually thereafter in the office of the Municipal Clerk.

B. Such fee shall be as set forth in the "Schedule of Rates and Fees" as shown on Exhibit 1 of this code. **Additional information at Town Hall**
