14.707. HALLOWEEN. TRICK OR TREAT.

Any person under twelve (12) years of age may participate in the act of "Trick or Treat" on Halloween night. All persons under said age shall be accompanied by a parent or responsible person. All "Trick or Treat" activities shall normally be conducted between 5:00pm and 8:00pm. This section shall not apply to organized and supervised Halloween parties such as schools, churches, private homes, etc.

HERE ARE A FEW SAFETY TIPS:

- 01) Choose face paint and makeup whenever possible instead of masks, which can obstruct a child's vision.
- 02) Cross the street at corners, using traffic signals and crosswalks.
- 03) Decorate costumes and bags with reflective tape or stickers and, if possible, choose light colors.
- 04) Have kids carry glow sticks and flashlights to help them see and be seen by drivers.
- 05) Put electronic devices down and keep heads up and walk, don't run, across the street.
- 06) When selecting a costume, make sure it is the right size to prevent trips and falls.

FIRE SAFETY TIPS

Install smoke alarms

Never leave cooking unattended.

Always wear short or tight-fitting sleeves when you cook.

Keep towels, potholders and curtains away from flames

Never use the range or oven to heat your home.

Have an escape plan

Place space heaters at least three feet away from flammable/combustible materials.

Keep matches/lighters away from children.

Never smoke in bed or when drowsy or medicated.

Inspect extension cords for frayed or exposed wires or loose plugs

Make sure outlets have cover plates and no exposed wiring.

Make sure wiring does not run under rugs, over nails, or across high traffic areas.

Do not overload extension cords or outlets.

Stop, drop, and roll until the fire is extinguished.
