18.304. BLOCKING STREET AND ALLEYS.

No person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle upon a street other than an alley, in such a manner or under such conditions as to obstruct the well-traveled portion of the roadway, except that a driver may stop temporarily during the actual loading or unloading of passengers or when necessary in obedience to traffic regulations or traffic signs or signals of a police officer. No person shall park a vehicle in an alley in such a manner or under such conditions as to leave available less than ten (10) feet of width of the roadway for the free movement of vehicular traffic.

18.305. MANNER OF PARKING.

Where parking is permitted on streets not marked off for parking, the operator of any vehicle shall park such vehicle with the **right front and right rear wheels** as near as possible to the curb and parallel thereto. Vehicles parked within marked areas shall not occupy any part of more than one (1) space. The operator of any parked vehicle shall back out into the roadway only when the roadway is clear.
