Website and boat rental terms for Go Dreamz Boat Rentals

Website Policy

These Terms and Conditions ("Terms") apply to the website, reservations, and boat rental services offered by Go Dreamz Boat Rentals ("Go Dreamz," "Rental Company," "we," "us," or "our").

By submitting a reservation, making payment, or using our rental services, you agree to these Terms and any applicable Boat Rental Agreement, Waiver and Release of Liability, payment authorization, safety instructions, and other documents required by Go Dreamz Boat Rentals.

1. Rental Eligibility

The primary renter must be at least 21 years of age.

A person operating the watercraft must meet all eligibility requirements established by Go Dreamz Boat Rentals and applicable law.

Anyone under 18 years of age may not operate the watercraft.

The renter is responsible for identifying all operators and passengers using the boat and for ensuring that all individuals comply with applicable rental and safety requirements.

2. Boat Capacity

Our pontoon boat has a maximum total capacity of seven (7) persons, including the captain/operator.

The renter may not exceed the vessel's rated capacity at any time.

3. Lake Lanier Use Only

Rental watercraft may be operated only on Lake Lanier, Georgia unless Go Dreamz Boat Rentals provides express written authorization otherwise.

The renter may not sublease, transfer, lend, or rent the boat to another person or party.

4. Reservations and Payment

The total estimated rental fee is due at the time of booking unless Go Dreamz Boat Rentals expressly agrees otherwise.

Additional charges may include:

- Fuel based on actual usage
- Security deposit
- Rental accessories
- Damage or missing-equipment charges
- Cleaning charges
- Late checkout charges

- Other fees authorized by the applicable rental agreement

Fuel, incidental charges, damage costs, and other authorized amounts may be deducted from the security deposit when applicable. If amounts owed exceed the security deposit, the remaining balance may be charged to the payment method authorized by the renter.

5. Cancellation & Refund Policy - 10 DAYS

Cancellation 10 or more calendar days before the scheduled check-in date:

The customer is eligible for a full refund of the rental amount paid.

Cancellation less than 10 calendar days before the scheduled check-in date:

The reservation is non-refundable.

No refund will be provided for a cancellation received within the 10-day non-refundable period unless Go Dreamz Boat Rentals expressly agrees otherwise in writing.

This 10-day cancellation policy replaces any older website reference to a 5-day cancellation period.

Rescheduling or credits offered outside these terms are at the sole discretion of Go Dreamz Boat Rentals and should not be considered guaranteed.

6. Weather and Unsafe Conditions

Weather conditions on Lake Lanier can change. No refunds for cancellations due to weather conditions.

7. Late Arrival and No-Shows

Your rental begins at the scheduled reservation time, not at the time you arrive.

Customers arriving more than 30 minutes late may lose their reservation and may be charged the full booking amount.

If you know that you will be delayed and wish to begin more than 30 minutes after your scheduled departure, please notify us by text at least three (3) hours before the scheduled departure time whenever possible.

Arriving late does not extend the rental.

For example, if you reserve a four-hour rental and arrive one hour late, approximately three hours of rental time will remain. No refund will be provided for unused rental time caused by late arrival.

8. Safe Operation

The renter and operator agree to:

- Operate the boat safely and carefully.
- Use the boat only for lawful purposes.
- Follow all local, state, and federal boating laws.
- Follow all safety and operational instructions provided by Go Dreamz Boat Rentals.
- Never operate the boat while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Never operate the boat carelessly, recklessly, or negligently.
- Never use the boat in a race or competition.
- Never exceed the vessel's rated passenger capacity.
- Immediately report accidents, damages, malfunctions, or safety concerns to Go Dreamz Boat Rentals.

9. Life Jackets and Minor Passengers

Go Dreamz Boat Rentals provides required safety equipment, including life jackets as required by law.

Under the rental agreement, children under age 13 must wear a life jacket at all times and before stepping onto the boat.

Go Dreamz Boat Rentals strongly recommends that all passengers wear a life jacket at all times while on or around the water.

The renter accepting responsibility for a minor represents that he or she is authorized to do so on behalf of that minor.

10. Renter Responsibility for Boat and Equipment

The renter is responsible for the boat and all accessories throughout the entire rental period until the watercraft has been properly returned and accepted by Go Dreamz Boat Rentals.

This responsibility continues during weather or unforeseen circumstances requiring the boat to remain secured in the water.

The renter is responsible for properly securing the boat and may be responsible for damage resulting from improper docking, anchoring, tying, or securing of the watercraft.

The boat must be returned in substantially the same condition in which it was received, except for reasonable normal wear and tear.

11. Prohibited Activities and Items

The following are not permitted on or with Go Dreamz Boat Rentals watercraft:

- Smoking
- Illegal drugs
- Red wine
- Pets
- Beaching the boat
- Operating closer than 150 feet to land, islands, trees, beaches, or similar hazards, as specified in the rental instructions

Failure to follow these rules may result in charges for cleaning, repair, damage, loss of rental privileges, or other remedies permitted under the rental agreement.

12. Checkout and Boat Return

The boat must be returned to the designated pickup/return point before the scheduled checkout time.

At checkout:

- All passengers and personal belongings must be removed.
- The boat must be clean and empty.
- Rented accessories must be returned in good condition.
- Any known damage must immediately be reported.
- Used or wet life jackets should be left as instructed by Go Dreamz staff so they can properly dry.

Official checkout occurs when the boat is clean, empty, and handed over to a Go Dreamz Boat Rentals team member.

13. Late Checkout Fee

Late checkout is charged at \$10 per minute.

For example, returning the boat 10 minutes late may result in a \$100 late checkout charge.

Customers should plan their return time accordingly.

14. Cleaning Fee

The renter must remove trash, food crumbs, personal belongings, and other debris.

A boat returned dirty or unclean may be subject to a \$150 cleaning fee.

Additional charges may apply where stains or damage require professional repair or replacement.

15. Damage and Repair Responsibility

The renter is financially responsible for loss or damage occurring during the rental period when the renter is responsible under the rental agreement.

Damage may be evaluated and repaired by a certified marine mechanic or qualified repair provider.

Under the rental agreement, applicable repair charges may include the repair invoice plus 25%.

The damage schedule contained in the rental agreement includes estimates such as:

- Red mud stains: \$150 or more
- Front navigation light: \$35
- Rear navigation light: \$75
- Seat tear: \$425 minimum; replacement may exceed \$1,500
- Stereo: \$350
- Stereo speaker: \$150
- Antenna: \$100
- Carpet stain or burn: \$75 minimum; replacement may exceed \$1,500
- Jet pump damage: \$1,500
- Ladder damage: \$225
- Bimini top damage/replacement: \$3,200
- Gel-coat scratches or damage: \$300 minimum; extensive repairs may exceed \$3,000

These amounts are estimates and are not an exhaustive list or maximum limitation on liability. Actual repair, replacement, labor, parts, professional services, and related costs may be charged when applicable.

16. Post-Rental Inspection

The boat may be inspected before and after each rental.

Existing damage may be documented before departure.

Go Dreamz Boat Rentals may have up to 48 hours after the rental, and before the boat is rented again, to discover and notify the renter of damage that was not identified during the initial return inspection.

Missing or damaged safety equipment, accessories, flotation devices, fire extinguishers, throw devices, anchors, or other equipment may be charged to the renter as permitted by the rental agreement.

If renter-caused damage makes the boat unavailable for subsequent rentals, the renter may also be responsible for applicable revenue loss as provided in the rental agreement.

17. Mechanical Issues

Any mechanical malfunction or problem must be reported immediately.

A claimed mechanical problem does not automatically entitle the renter to a refund. No refund relating to a reported mechanical failure will be determined until Go Dreamz Boat Rentals has had an opportunity to inspect the watercraft for operator negligence, misuse, or abuse.

18. Assumption of Risk

Boating, swimming, tubing, watersports, and the operation or use of watercraft involve inherent risks, including the possibility of property damage, bodily injury, illness, disability, or death.

Participation is voluntary.

As a condition of rental, renters, operators, passengers, parents, and/or guardians may be required to execute a separate Boat Rental Agreement, Waiver and Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk, Covenant Not to Sue, Indemnity Agreement, and Payment Authorization before using the watercraft.

The renter assumes responsibility for complying with those documents and for ensuring that disclosed passengers and operators comply with applicable safety requirements.

19. Release and Indemnification

To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law and as more specifically provided in the signed rental agreement, the renter may be required to assume specified risks and release, defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Go Dreamz Boat Rentals and its applicable owners, employees, agents, representatives, successors, insurers, and affiliates from claims, losses, liabilities, expenses, property damage, and injuries arising from or connected with the rental or use of the watercraft.

The separate signed Rental Agreement and Waiver contains additional important legal terms and should be read carefully before signing.

20. Credit Card Authorization

By providing an authorized payment method and entering into the applicable rental agreement, the renter authorizes Go Dreamz Boat Rentals to collect amounts properly owed under the rental agreement, which may include:

- Rental charges
- Actual fuel usage
- Late charges
- Cleaning charges
- Missing equipment
- Damage and repair charges
- Other authorized rental-related amounts

A security deposit or available credit-card balance does not necessarily limit the renter's responsibility for damages or amounts otherwise owed under the rental agreement.

21. Governing Law

These Terms and applicable rental agreements shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Georgia, except where applicable law requires otherwise.

22. Arbitration and Disputes

As provided in the rental agreement, disputes arising from the rental relationship are to be pursued through arbitration in Hall County, Georgia, rather than through court proceedings, to the extent permitted by applicable law.

Additional dispute-resolution, attorney-fee, cost, and indemnification provisions may appear in the signed rental agreement.

23. Severability

If any portion of these Terms is determined to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will remain in effect to the extent permitted by applicable law.

24. Additional Rental Agreement

These website Terms provide general conditions governing reservations and rentals but do not replace the Boat Rental Agreement and Waiver that customers may be required to sign before operating or using the boat.

Specific booking information, rental dates and times, payment terms, security deposits, accessories, passenger information, and additional waivers may be included in the customer's rental documents.

25. Changes to These Terms

Go Dreamz Boat Rentals may update these Terms from time to time. The version posted on the website at the time of booking will apply, together with the customer's applicable rental documents.
