

Recital Tickets

When will Recital tickets go on sale?

Recital tickets will go on sale Saturday April 15, 2023 online at www.PureEnergyDanceFoundation.com/Recital-and-Picture-Day Tickets are not available at the door as our Events always sell out.

Can I purchase tickets at the studio?

No, tickets are only available through the link above.

How much do tickets cost?

Tickets are \$25.00 each

Please print your tickets or save them on your phone. We are unable to read bar codes

Everyone entering the theater must have a ticket this includes all siblings regardless of age.

Families with dancers in multiple shows must have tickets to each show they wish to watch.

Will the seats be socially distanced?

The theater is spacious, giving those that wish to social distance the opportunity to sit away from the majority of the audience and still have a great view of the performance.

Will there be a livestream option to watch the show?

Due to Additional cost we do not provide a livestream to the show. A downloadable link to the recital can be purchased at the time tickets are purchased. The Link will be emailed early August.

Is there a limit on the number of tickets I can purchase?

We do not limit the number of tickets a family may purchase, as it is important we sell as many tickets as possible to cover the theater Rental Cost. Please place your Order Quickly as we will Sell Out.

Can my dancer watch the show in the audience with me?

Entering and Exiting the Theater creates a disturbance to other audience memb<mark>er</mark>s, all dancers remain backstage for the entire recital. Staff will assist with costume changes when needed.

Is there a chance that the show my dancer is in will sell out?

Yes, Our Recit<mark>als</mark> always sell out, so please place your or<mark>der</mark> as soon as possible. Tickets are sold on a first come, first serve bases.

Will my seats be reserved or general admission?

We would like to create an organized and professional atmosphere, all tickets are non-reserved seating, doors will open 15 minutes before each show time, this is a first come first serve seating. Each member of your party <u>must</u> have a ticket to enter the theater regardless of age. No Children will be allowed to sit on a parents lap.

When can I enter the Venue on the day of the show?

The doors to the building will not open until call time for the dancers. The theater doors will open 15 minutes prior to show time.

If my dancer is in multiple shows on the same day, can I stay in the venue for the next show?

No, we ask that family members not linger in the Venue. Family members wishing to watch multiple shows must have tickets for each show.

Dress Rehearsal

Dress Rehearsal is a very important part of the Recital experience. Dress Rehearsal is the first time the dancers will perform full-out in their costume with their hair and makeup complete.

Attendance at Picture Day is required for all dancers even if you are not purchasing a Media Package.

Should my dancer arrive to Dress Rehearsal in costume?

Yes, all dancers should arrive in full costume, tights, and Hair for Dress Rehearsal

Will there be a changing area for my dancer who has multiple routines/costumes for Dress Rehearsal?

Dancers will use an empty studio to change costumes. Staff will be available to aid in costume changes.

Can I video my dancer at Dress Rehearsal?

Our Dress Rehearsal is a closed Rehearsal. Parents are not allowed to attend.

How long should I plan on being at Dress Rehearsal?

Dancers will be required to be at the studio for

Show 1 - 1.5 hours

Show 2 - 3 hours





The Big Day!

This is the big day your dancer has worked for all year! Your dancer will be very excited and it's going to be so much fun to take the stage and perform! We want to make this experience the best it can be for you and your dancer, so please continue to read all the details below carefully.

When do I need to arrive at the theater?

Please do not enter the building prior to these times.

Show 1 - 5:00 p.m.

Show 2 - 7:00 p.m.

Where do I drop off my dancer?

Teachers / Student Teachers will collect dancers in the main Lobby.

Please do not enter the backstage hallway or changerooms as we have a short time to clear the dancers for the next show.

Who can drop off my dancer?

Anyone can drop off your dancer.

Should my dancer arrive at the venue in costume?

Dancers should arrive at the theater in full costume including Tights, Hair and Make up, as there will not be time at the theater to get your dancer ready.

Will my dancer be able to watch the show?

Entering and Exiting the Theater creates a disturbance to other audience members, all dancers remain backstage for the entire recital. Staff will assist with costume changes when needed.

Can I go backstage or to the dressing room to assist my dancer in between routines?

No, Parents are not all<mark>owed</mark> in the dre<mark>ssin</mark>g rooms for any reason.

Entering and Exiting the Theater is a distraction for other Audience Members.

What Should I Bring?

All dancers must bring a labelled bag with extra hair spray, brush, hair elastics.

Don't forget your costumes, tights and shoes.

FOOD and DRINK: Costumes are easily ruined by food and drink stains. Please only pack water in a non-leaking water bottle. Please DO NOT send any food.

Children are discouraged from bring any valuables including phones, Ipods, Ipads and laptops as the Venue and Pure Energy Dance will not take responsibility for any items lost, damaged or stolen.

Please leave toys at home.

Dismissal Policy and Procedures:

Please wait in the Lobby for Teachers / Teacher Assistance to bring your dancer to you. Please do not enter the change room hallway as this will delay us in getting dancers to their parents and set for our next show.

Audience Etiquette

Here are a few etiquette guidelines to help you and your fellow audience members enjoy the show fully.

Everyone Needs a Ticket - Parents, Toddlers, Grandparents, Friends. Everyone attending the recital needs to purchase a ticket as seats are limited. While children are welcome to attend they must remain seated during the performances. If you feel that your child may not be able to remain focused for the performances it is recommended that they do not attend.

Silence or Turn off your Devices - Please turn off cell phones; tablets, and any other electronic devices prior to the performance starting. You should never speak, text, or play games on your electronic devices during a performance. You should also not check your device during a performance since the backlight is incredibly bright and distracting to other audience members and is also visible and dangerous to the dancers on stage.

No Entrance / Exits - Our recital is designed to flow quickly between performance pieces. Please do not enter or exit unless it is an emergency. If you have a fussy child please exit as quietly as possible in order to minimize the disruption to your fellow audience members.

No Video or Pictures - In conjunction with Copyright and Chi<mark>ld Safety Laws, personal pho</mark>tography or Video recording is strictly prohibited. we have employed a professional videographers to capture these memories for you! Please place your order when you order your tickets.

Curtain Call - The performance is over at the conclusion of curtain call (When every dancer comes onstage to take their final bow). Audience members should stay for the entire performance and should not leave early during the curtain call. Please stay in your seat until the performance is over and the house lights are raised. Then, exit with the rest of the audience. This policy is in place to show respect and appreciation to all of our performers.

No Backstage Access - No one is allowed backstage except for dancers, volunteers and instructors. Dancers will be released from the Lobby following the curtain call. No dancers will be released at intermission or at any other time throughout the recital. Please rest assured that we have a number of staff backstage to help your dancer throughout the entire process.

Enjoy the Show! - this one is the most important, sit back relax and enjoy the performances. The dancers have worked hard on these performances and they love hearing the audience's enthusiasm and applause.

Stage Makeup and Hair

Does my dancer need to wear makeup for Dress Rehearsal and the Recital?

Yes! The lights on the stage are very bright, and the theater is large! All dancers will need to wear makeup for Photo day, dress rehearsal and the show. This will make their beautiful faces stand out on stage and not be washed out by the lights.

For Recreational dancers, Light Blush Color to match Skin, Pink Lipstick, and Mascara. Competitive dancers should wear competition makeup.

All dancers should look their best for the big day!

How do I style my dancer's hair for Dress Rehearsal and the Recital?

For uniformity, we assign each class a specific hairstyle for the performance. This hairstyle is listed in the Show Chart in this packet! Please make sure you are aware of this hairstyle! Hair should be as neat and clean as possible. This is a special day, so you should make a special effort to help your dancer look their best! Use gel/clips/hairspray to smooth fly-aways so that all dancers have a classy and uniform look on stage! If you have a hairpiece, please also make sure it is very secure so that it does not fall off during the performance! Dress Rehearsal is just as important – so please do hair and makeup for this day just as you would for the show!
