The Sunset Lake Association (SLA) was formed in 1982 to help protect our natural resource, promote waterfront-living education, and work with local agencies who also wish to keep the lake beautiful and healthy for current and future generations. With the support of our members, the SLA monitors the lake for invasive species, performs regular water testing in conjunction with the University of New Hampshire, monitors and maintains the water level through dam adjustments, assists in the annual loon population count, promotes healthy waterfront living and landscaping, and provides educational information about lakeside living, boating, and wildlife. We also hold social events to help unite the Sunset Lake community.

We have completely revamped our website at www.slahampstead.org and it now includes many improvements including easy to interpret water quality results, Sunset Lake merchandise, and much more information on beach access, boat launching access and rules, waterfront living and landscaping, lake plants and invasive species, and much more.
