We continue to make progress on mitigating the two *shoreline* invasive plant species on the lake; Purple Loosestrife and Common Reed (Phragmites). We want to thank the SLA members and landowners who have helped us to mitigate these plants. We are making great progress and we hope to be free of these two invasives in the next couple of years.

We also hope that you will consider participating in the NH Lakes LakeSmart Lake-Friendly Living Program which NH Lakes is improving for 2025 to make it easier and more engaging. This program is a voluntary education and recognition program with the goal of encouraging property owners to maintain their homes and property in ways that protect lake water quality, wildlife habitat, and property values.
