Welcome to the lake!

Sunset Lake, also known as Wash Pond, is approximately 1 mile long and 1/2 mile wide (151 acres), and about 30 to 35 feet deep at the center. The town of Hampstead maintains a beach on Sunset Lake which is open to all town residents. Boat launching is available at the town beach for those with waterfront property, right-ofway, or deeded access to the lake. There is no public boat launch on the lake.

The Sunset Lake Association (SLA) was formed in 1982 to help protect our natural resource, promote waterfront-living education, and work with local agencies who also wish to keep the lake beautiful and healthy for current and future generations. Together, we:

Monitor the lake for invasive species, perform regular water testing in conjunction with the University of New Hampshire Lakes Lay Monitoring Program, assist with New Hampshire's annual loon population count, promote healthy waterfront living and landscaping, provide boater safety education with the NH Marine Patrol, clean local roads through the Hampstead town road adoption program, and maintain the lake water level through monitoring weather conditions and adjusting the dam accordingly.

The SLA also holds social events such as a decorated boat parade, paddle events, and virtual fire pit parties. We hold an annual meeting in July and all members, interested parties, and their guests are invited to attend.

All who enjoy Sunset Lake are invited and encouraged to join the SLA. The annual dues, starting at the SLA Supporter level of \$25, are small in comparison with the good work of this volunteer organization. We also offer a lifetime SLA Supporter membership of \$250 (non-transferrable). We offer 3 levels of membership upgrades supporting various preservation initiatives.
