Our adoption fees are determined by the costs of preparing our dogs for adoption (vet examination, spay/neuter, tattoo/microchip, vaccinations, teeth cleaning, if necessary, de-worming etc.) and includes a martingale collar, a leash, a tag collar, and a kennel muzzle. These are determined based upon each dogs needs and are variable.

The **Adoption/Foster Application** is not an agreement to adopt a dog. More questions may follow, plus an interview, vet reference check, and possibly a home check – but this will get us started. We will use your answers as a starting point to work with you to determine, first, whether a Greyhound is really what you're looking for. If it is, we will also be able to help you select a pet who will fit in well with your lifestyle and expectations. Some individuals may find this process a bit intrusive, but we have found that thorough evaluation of our dogs and of prospective adopters helps to ensure that our placements are successful and permanent.
