Hello there,

Thanks for your interest in adopting a greyhound from The Greyt Project! Below you'll find some more information about our group, the dogs we typically see, and our standard adoption process.

The Greyt Project is run by a group of dedicated volunteers following non-profit methods. At this time we are not officially designated as a non-profit organization or registered charity but are seeking designation.

We work to rehome greyhounds, primarily those that have run in recreational social matches here in Vancouver BC's Lower Mainland. These dogs are either brought over from Ireland and abroad when they are young or bred here. We can receive them at any age but generally they are between 2-5 years old. Most are raised in a mixture of indoor/outdoor environments so have some house training. Generally, they are very sweet dogs, but tend to be slightly more extroverted than greyhounds from a racetrack background.

Our adoption fees are entirely determined based upon the cost of feeding and vetting needed by the dog in question and as such are variable. All dogs receive general wellness check, microchipping, vaccine update, spay/neuter and dental care as needed. The general range of this medical cost is \$1000-2000. We provide record of all medical history and receipts when adopted. At this time as we are a new group we do not have donations or other income that can subsidize the adoption fee.

Please complete the adoption application form attached here to be considered as either a potential foster, foster-to-adopt or adopter. Once we have reviewed your application you will be contacted to arrange a phone call and if this seems like a potential fit this would be followed by a home inspection, which may be in-person or virtual.
