Dominating Pre-hospital Hemorrhage is a 4-hour workshop hosted by the NWA Fire/EMS Conference and was developed by Fortis Training Concepts, to promote aggressive management of bleeding patients by the first care provider at the point of injury. It may be attended independently or as an adjunct to the CRASE course. Through lectures and a series of hands-on skill stations, this curriculum explores the evolution and application of bleeding control measures in the field, and lessons learned that lead to the current standard. Basic to advanced methods of bleeding management will be discussed and demonstrated ranging from pressure dressings and tourniquets to hemostatic agents and junctional tourniquets. Special emphasis will be placed on the effects of blood loss and maximizing clotting potential through understanding the effects of interventions, management of body temperature and use of pharmacology. Attendees will be provided with an in-depth understanding of the tools available in the prehospital setting and their proper application with the goal of improving field treatment of the volume compromised trauma patient.
