The AAIR course is designed to improve integration between law enforcement, fire, telecommunicator and EMS in active attack/shooter events. The course provides law enforcement officers with key medical skills based on tactical emergency casualty care guidelines, which can be used at the point of injury to increase survivability of victims.

The course also provides a model framework for law enforcement, fire, and EMS to integrate responses during an active attack/shooter event through the rescue task force concept.

This course has been designed to improve the safety and survivability of victims of active attack / shooter events and increase the effectiveness, coordination, and resource integration between law enforcement, fire, tele-communications and EMS when responding to these events.

Prerequisite: Participants must be state-certified law enforcement, fire, Telecommunicator or EMS providers. EMS providers should be EMT-B certified (preferably EMT-I or EMT-P).

Required Equipment: Good attitude, open mind, pen and paper, duty gear or training uniform
