GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEP-ER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

August 28, 2022

22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

People who are concerned with their own advancement and agenda have little room for anyone else. With an almost addictive pursuit of esteem and acknowledgment from others, they become little more than entitled embodiments of the vice of pride. Public humiliation or embarrassment can hit them hard. While avoiding humiliation and embarrassment may be advantageous to obtaining worldly success, they are much less desirable motivations for entering the Kingdom of God. Avoiding embarrassment is a self-serving motivation. Pride and all of its manifestations have no place on God's agenda, neither do worldly success and fulfillment. In fact, we have been clearly told that if we love our lives, we will lose them. Therefore, if you really want to find your true station in life, learn to give yourself away.

While this may sound foolish to secular ears, it actually makes perfect sense. God, who is love, makes each of us in His image. Love, and therefore God, is in our DNA. That being the case, love is never love if it is kept to oneself or hoarded. Love needs to be shared and given away. Therefore, it is the only proper motivation for entering the Kingdom of God. The door to happiness is only opened when we realize that all we are and all we have is due only to God's grace. Without God we are nothing.

Love is the remedy for pride and protects us from ourselves. God asks us to be humble. Only when we are free from the traps of pride and arrogance that we can begin to follow the path to true humility. Only one who is humble can rightly love and be of service to God. "God makes use only of the humble as his instruments (Jean-Pierre de Caussade)." The humble one does not need others to give them worth and value. Their self-esteem comes from the much more secure foundation of God. Only those who are entirely free can give themselves freely to others. Love must always be our motivation for doing all things. Be content that God has invited you to the banquet of life. Concern yourself with accepting the invitation, and don't worry about where you will sit.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO – ALENTAR UN ENTENDIMIENTO MÁS PROFUNDO DE LA ESCRITURA

El mundo de las apariencias, de la fama y el prestigio no tiene nada que ver con el Evangelio que predica Jesús. Las fiestas de ahora son en ocasiones vanas, solo se trata de presumir quien trae el mejor vestido, el mejor traje o peinado. Se ve quienes son los más importantes. La fiesta de Jesús es diferente. La fiesta del Reino es de pobres y lisiados, sin hogar y enfermos. Habrá de toda raza, color, gordos y delgados. Serán protagonistas de ser amigos de Jesús. Es la fiesta de la humildad y la gratitud. Palabras tan cortitas y sencillas que encierran la verdad del camino. La primera lectura las describe así: “El hombre sabio medita las máximas en su corazón; todo lo que el sabio desea, es hallar a alguien que lo escuche” (Eclesiastés 3,29). ¿Cómo practicas la sabiduría que Dios te ha dado?

Pareciera que Dios nos pide siempre escoger el camino más difícil. El trabajo más pesado y el cargo más sencillo y sin importancia. Pero, si hiciéramos una encuesta a ver quién es más feliz en la sociedad, descubriremos que son las personas con dedicación, con sueños, que se esfuerzan por todo lo que desean, con sencillez y humildad. Como decía Cesar Chávez: “No podemos buscar logros para nosotros y olvidarnos del progreso y la prosperidad de nuestra comunidad...Nuestras ambiciones deben ser lo suficientemente amplias como para incluir las aspiraciones y necesidades de los demás, por su bien y por el nuestro”. ¿Qué te parece? ¡Estás preparado para la fiesta de Jesús!

Requisitos Para Bautizos

1. Padres y Padrinos deben estar registrados.
2. Padres y Padrinos deben tomar una clase pre-bautismal primero antes de apartar la fecha de bautismo.
3. Si los niños son mayores de 7 años tienen que tomar una clase especial.
4. Si los padres quieren que otro sacerdote bautice al niño, la familia debe comunicarse con ese sacerdote por su cuenta y luego comunicarse con la parroquia para programar la fecha.
5. Si los padrinos están en otra parroquia pueden tomar las clases en esa parroquia y traer una carta con sello enseñando que tomaron las clases en su parroquia.
6. Los Padrinos tienen que tener:
 - 15 años o más
 - Ser bautizado en la iglesia Católica
 - Tener certificado de Confirmación (**necesitamos una copia**)
7. Los padrinos solo pueden ser un hombre y una mujer casados por la iglesia o solo un hombre soltero y/o una sola mujer soltera.
8. Si los padrinos están casados por la iglesia **necesitamos una copia del certificado de matrimonio.**
10. Se pide una donación de \$40.00 para la iglesia para ayudar con el sustento de la parroquia. Por favor cubra esta donación al apartar la fecha.
