

FIESTA MEXICANA

First, I would like to say, as a parish, we have been truly blessed to have had many individuals who answered the call to service on behalf of the church and stepped up to lead the OLG Fiesta over the years. Thank you to all of the people who held this responsibility before through fun, exciting and extremely challenging times. We are forever grateful.

I am humbled that Father has asked me and each of the Committee Chairs to take on this responsibility for the 90th Annual Fiesta. We have been working diligently on getting our committees up and running. We are all very excited to bring back the Fiesta in full force, celebrating the rich heritage and culture of our Church and community.

We are blessed to have David and Sarah Chavez from Ingenuity as volunteer consultants to the Fiesta Committee. They are experts in branding, marketing, special event producers, and building relationships. They are working with us on the brand logo for the Fiesta and rolling out a strategic media plan. Our goal is to spread the word across all social media avenues that we are back and ready to provide a memorable experience with our traditional Mexican food, music, art, and dance.

Our Food Chair, Gina Barron, is developing a schedule for the Food Prep. One of the changes that will be implemented is to spice the meat later in the Spring so that it will not be in the freezer as long. Another key change is that we will be increasing the number of tamales made for the Fiesta. In 2019, we made approximately 4,600 tamales and sold out each day by 5:30 pm. We are planning to double the number of tamales that we make to 9,200 for the 2023 Fiesta which will require more time, day and night shifts, and a lot of hands to help prepare them.

Our Finance Chair, Laura Rubio, and I are working on the proposed Fiesta budget which we will present to the Finance Council for their review and approval later this month.

We are also still looking for Royalty candidates. Rosa Cavazos will be providing a status update soon.

Manny Martinez, our IT Chair, is working to make sure we have the bandwidth needed to handle our technical needs during the Fiesta. He is evaluating the possibility of an online food ordering app and looking into obtaining a QR code.

We will continue to provide updates in the bulletin to keep you informed of what is happening with the Fiesta. Please keep all of the Fiesta leadership in your prayers and ask Our Lord to guide us and give us the wisdom to make good decisions on behalf of our church and Fiesta.
