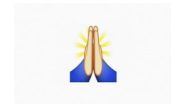

VIDA PARROQUIAL

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

10 de octubre de 2021
28º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Hemos vivido en estos dos años experiencias inimaginables en nuestras vidas. Si hace tres años nos hubieran dicho que esto de la pandemia pasaría, no lo hubiéramos creído. Sin embargo, el tiempo de confinamiento en casa, el cuidarnos los unos a los otros, el distanciamiento y la limpieza, junto con el ser vacunados, nos ha llevado a apreciar y creer lo que escuchamos hoy en la liturgia de la Palabra. La primera lectura describe con lujo de detalle lo que es apreciar lo más importante: *“Oré y me fue dada la inteligencia; supliqué, y el espíritu de sabiduría vino a mí. La preferí a los cetros y a los tronos, y estimé en nada la riqueza al lado de ella” (Sabiduría 7:7-8)*. ¿Qué nos enseña esta lectura con referencia al tiempo que estamos viviendo? ¿Qué debemos de apreciar ahora?

Bueno, para seguir reflexionando, Jesús en el Evangelio lo pone clarísimo con un mensaje exigente y radical, poniendo en contraste la riqueza y la sabiduría. Su mensaje: *“Sólo te falta una cosa; vete, vende todo lo que tienes y reparte el dinero entre los pobres, y tendrás un tesoro en el Cielo. Después ven y sígueme” (Mateo 10:21)*. Más claro que el agua no puede ser. Seguir a Jesús es el siguiente paso.

¿Cómo? Dándonos unos a otros hasta que duela.

Los pobres son el gran camino para el cielo y creo que durante el confinamiento que hemos vivido todos somos pobres, porque a todos nos falta de alguna manera la salud, el trabajo, y todos hemos perdido a algún ser querido durante este tiempo. ¿Qué opinas de la invitación de Jesús? ¿Crees que es actual o está pasada de moda?

MANTENIÉNDOLE AL CONOCIMIENTO

En el boletín de julio, dije que un deseo para nuestro MCBAC serían las nuevas puertas de entrada (sur). Más recientemente, cuando tuvimos la venta de garaje para la iglesia, me costó mucho utilizar la cuerda elástica para mantener la puerta abierta. Era muy difícil de configurar y seguía aflojándose si alguien entraba o salía hasta que finalmente entraba en la posición de bloqueo. Estoy segura de que muchos de ustedes han experimentado la frustración de abrir las puertas del Centro de actividades y mantenerlas abiertas.

Puede preguntar ¿no hay otra forma de desbloquear estas puertas? Cuando comencé en esta posición, una llave tipo llave Allen específica la mantendría desbloqueada. Esto funcionó de maravilla, excepto cuando la llave se quitaba o se perdía de alguna manera una y otra vez. Además, las barras de pánico eventualmente se eliminarían y tendrían que comprarse barras nuevas al precio de \$1,200 cada una. Entonces ... la cuerda elástica fue una forma inventada de mantener las puertas abiertas sin llave de forma bastante económica. Han pasado los años y yo llevo aquí 8 años y hay que poner la cuerda elástica en reposo. La última oferta oficial fue en 2019 y fue de \$9,375. Han pasado dos años y medio y estoy seguro de que ahora han subido a \$10 - \$12,000. Recibiré una nueva oferta por estas puertas para poder tener un precio más preciso. Por favor, considere con espíritu de oración si está siendo llamado a donar a las nuevas puertas de entrada de MCBAC.

KEEPING YOU IN THE KNOW

In July bulletin, I stated that a *Want* for our MCBAC would be new Entrance (South) Doors. Most recently when we had the garage sale for the church, I had a very hard time utilizing the bungee cord to keep the door unlocked. It was very hard to set, and it kept loosening if someone came in or out till it eventually went into the locked position. I'm sure many of you have experienced the frustration of unlocking the Activity Center doors and keeping them unlocked.

You may ask isn't there another way to unlock these doors? When I first started in this position a specific allen wrench type key would keep it unlocked. This worked wonderfully except when the key would be taken or lost somehow over and over.

Also, the panic bars would eventually become stripped and new bars at the price of \$1200 each would have to be purchased. So...the bungee cord was an invented way to keep the doors unlocked rather cheaply. Years have gone by, and I've been here 8 years and the bungee cord needs to be put to rest. The last official bid was in 2019 and it was \$9,375. Two and a half years have gone by and I'm sure that has now gone up to \$10 - \$12,000. I will get a new bid on these doors so I can have a more accurate price.

Please prayerfully consider if you are being called to donate to new MCBAC Entrance Doors.
