GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

October 16, 2022

29th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Brendan wouldn't stop. He continued nagging his mom to let him have a little more time with his phone. He knew the rules but wanted to finish a game and text a few more friends. He begged, had a temper tantrum, pleaded, screamed, pouted, and used every means he could think of to get Mom to change her mind. Mom had a busy day and was tired. At first, she held her ground. Then, her son's persistence got the best of her, and she caved. "Brendan, you can have 30 more minutes and no more!" she retorted. Brendan's determination paid off. He won.

Is this how it works with God too? If we want something enough and feel it is our due, does our persistence allow us to eventually get our way? Judging God by human standards, it would seem so. But is this the way God works? It gets a bit confusing when Jesus tells his disciples to "pray always without becoming weary" and then further tells them how God will "secure the rights of his chosen ones who call out to him day and night." If we catch God at the right time, when he's having a weak moment, then our tenacity ought to pay off. What we want, we will get. Really? Sadly, the way many approach prayer suggests that this is precisely how it goes.

Good parents set boundaries and offer proper discipline. They learn the art of being steadfast when presented with determined minds and wills. They know what is best and, at times, have to say "no." God is always there with His full attention and unconditional love showering itself upon us. God also knows what is best. And, as with any good parent, the one constant that is always available and never withheld is love. We can be as persistent and determined as we want if what we are seeking is God's love. We are never a bother and requests for God's love are never denied. This is the prayer of the heart. Desiring God alone and not only what we want God to do for us places this love relationship foremost in our minds, hearts, and souls. God is never bothered by this prayer. As we breathe in and exhale out, the Divine Life freely flows.

(Gospel Meditations)

16 de octubre de 2022

29° Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Demos una miradita a nuestro mundo. ¿Qué vez? ¿Qué escuchas? ¿Qué haces? Caemos en la cuenta de la situación política, social, económica y religiosa que nos rodea. Guerra, hambre, miles de personas sin hogar, niños y niñas sin educación, ancianos sin cuidado y sufriendo las consecuencias de tanta injusticia. ¿Se parece nuestro tiempo en algo a los tiempos de Jesús? La segunda Carta a Timoteo nos dice: *“predica la Palabra, insiste a tiempo y a destiempo, rebatiendo, reprendiendo o aconsejando, siempre con paciencia y dejando una enseñanza”* (2 de Timoteo 4,2). Esto no significa que debemos ir por la calle predicando a gritos la Palabra de Dios. Esto quiere decir que cada uno de nosotros tiene un compromiso misionero hacia los demás. El Papa Francisco, en la Exhortación Apostólica *Evangelii Gaudium*, número 273, nos anima y fortalece para ser misioneros valerosos, entusiasmados por el Espíritu Santo que vive en nosotros. *“Hay que reconocerse a sí mismo como marcado a fuego por esa misión de iluminar, bendecir, vivificar, levantar, sanar, liberar. Transmitir la belleza de Jesús... Ve con amor hacia todos, porque tu vida es una misión preciosa: no es un peso que soportar, sino un don para ofrecer. Ánimo, sin miedo, ¡vayamos al encuentro de todos!”* Buscando siempre la justicia, la concordia y el diálogo en las situaciones que la vida nos presente. El secreto para el éxito es orar siempre, confiar en Dios y seguir adelante con esperanza.

VIDA PARROQUIAL

Requisitos Para Bautizos

1. Padres y Padrinos deben estar registrados.
2. Padres y Padrinos deben tomar una clase pre-bautismal primero antes de apartar la fecha de bautismo.
3. Si los niños son mayores de 7 años tienen que tomar una clase especial.
4. Si los padres quieren que otro sacerdote bautice al niño, la familia debe comunicarse con ese sacerdote por su cuenta y luego comunicarse con la parroquia para programar la fecha.
5. Si los padrinos están en otra parroquia pueden tomar las clases en esa parroquia y traer una carta con sello enseñando que tomaron las clases en su parroquia.
6. Los Padrinos tienen que tener:
 - 15 años o más
 - Ser bautizado en la iglesia Católica
 - Tener certificado de Confirmación (**necesitamos una copia**)
7. Los padrinos solo pueden ser un hombre y una mujer casados por la iglesia o solo un hombre soltero y/o una sola mujer soltera.
8. Si los padrinos están casados por la iglesia **necesitamos una copia del certificado de matrimonio**.
10. Se pide una donación de \$40.00 para la iglesia para ayudar con el sustento de la parroquia. Por favor cubra esta donación al apartar la fecha.
11. Si tiene usted alguna pregunta llame a la oficina de la iglesia al **785.232.5088**.

REPORTING ABUSE OF A MINOR OR VULNERABLE ADULT

If you suspect a child or vulnerable adult is being abused or neglected, make a report to the Kansas Department for Children and Families Protection Report Center by calling (800) 922-5330. If you or someone you know has been abused by a cleric, employee, or volunteer of any archdiocesan parish, school, or agency — regardless of when the abuse may have occurred — call the archdiocesan confidential report line at (913) 647-3051 or the victim Care Advocate at (913) 298-9244, **after** calling local law enforcement. You can also make a report using the online form at: www.archkck.org/reportabuse. The Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas places the protection of children as its priority. The archdiocese respects the sincere concerns of all individuals who report misconduct and is committed to conducting thorough investigations of all allegations
