Reliquias sagradas de los santos: Tesoros De la Iglesia

La Parroquia de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe presenta una enseñanza y exposición de Reliquias Sagradas el jueves 29 de julio a las 6:30pm. El padre Carlos Martins de los Compañeros de la Cruz estará aquí con una extraordinaria colección del Vaticano de más de 150 reliquias, algunas de hasta 2000 años de vieja.

Entre los tesoros se encuentran las reliquias de San José, Santa María Goretti, Santa Teresa de Lisieux (la "Pequeña Flor"), San Francisco de Asís, San Antonio de Padua, Santo Tomás de Aquino y Santa Faustina Kowalska. También habrá una porción del Velo de Nuestra Señora y una de las piezas restantes más grandes de la Verdadera Cruz en el mundo.

Los asistentes podrán examinar y venerar cada reliquia. A lo largo de la historia, se han realizado muchas curaciones en presencia de reliquias; y miles han ocurrido a través de este ministerio. No te pierdas esta oportunidad. Se le anima a traer sus artículos de devoción (como rosarios, tarjetas sagradas, etc.) y fotografías de amigos / familiares enfermos, que podrá tocar en los relicarios como un medio de intercesión.

3. El micrófono para colocar sobre el oído que el P. Ray usa necesita una reparación de cable \$140
4. El congelador comercial estaba a 110 grados y se necesita una nueva unidad de condensación con evaporador...\$9,885
5. Dos candelabros estroboscópicos necesitan reparación y se reemplazaron otras bombillas \$1,100.50

Quiere

1. Los bancos de la capilla de Adoración necesitan reparación. Hay que rehacer los cojines.
2. Nos gustaría 2-3 carritos de libros con ruedas para colocar nuestros misales.

MCBAC(Centro de Actividades)

Necesario

1. Una nueva unidad de intercambio de calor en la entrada\$5,500

Quiere

1. Un nuevo sistema para controlar todos los termostatos desde un control oculto, ya sea en el MCBAC o por teléfono. La gente siempre está subiendo o bajando los controles, rompiendo las cajas de seguridad, encendiendo la calefacción en lugar del aire acondicionado.

KEEPING YOU IN THE KNOW

July 2021

Dearest Parishioners,

God is so good! Life seems to be getting somewhat back to normal with most of the Pandemic restraints being lifted. In the last month we have been hit with many new expenses that I want you to make you aware of.

CHURCH

Necessary

1. A new heat exchange unit is needed over the sacristy \$5500
2. Two new rooftop AC units (one over the choir loft and one on the North church roof)\$13-14,000. The church's AC has been running at 75% over the last month.
3. The over the ear microphone that Fr. Ray uses needs a cable repair\$140
4. The Walk-in Cooler was at 110 degrees and a new condensing unit with evaporator is needed... \$9,885
5. Two strobing chandeliers needed repair and other light bulbs were replaced \$1,100.50

Wants

1. The Adoration chapel pews need repair. The cushions need to be redone.
2. We would like 2-3 book carts on wheels to place our missals on.

MCBAC

Necessary

1. A new heat exchange unit in the entry way \$5,500

Wants

1. A new system to control all thermostats from one hidden control either in the McBac or by phone. People are always turning the controls up or down, breaking the lock boxes, turning the heat on instead of the AC...

NOTE: Utilities for the Church - May - \$498.67, June - \$1,318.89

Utilities for the MCBAC - May -\$621.17, June - \$2,352.33

2. New entrance doors (stop the bungee cord)

OFFICE

Necessary

1. Repair the sidewalk in front of the office per Catholic Mutual (our insurance company)
2. Rail on the handicapped ramp per Catholic Mutual

SOME REGULAR EXPENSES

1. Annual Fire Alarm Inspections and Annual Sprinkler Inspections for the Activity Center \$1,200
2. Annual Hood Suppression system in Activity Center \$826

Sacred Relics Of The Saints:

Treasures Of The Church

Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish presents a teaching and exposition of Sacred Relics on Thursday July 29 at 6:30 pm. Father Carlos Martins of the Companions of the Cross will be here with an extraordinary Vatican collection of over 150 relics, some as old as 2000 years. Among the treasures will be relics of St. Joseph, St. Maria Goretti, St. Therese of Lisieux (the "Little Flower"), St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Faustina Kowalska. There will also be a portion of the Veil of Our Lady and one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world. Those in attendance will be able to examine and venerate each relic. Throughout history, many healings have been worked in the presence of relics; and thousands have occurred through this ministry. Do not miss this opportunity. You are encouraged to bring your articles of devotion (such as rosaries, holy cards, etc.) and pictures of ill friends/family members, which you will be able to touch to the reliquaries as a means of intercession.

OLG VETERANS MEMORIAL UPDATE

As of this date 92% of the memorial bricks purchased have been engraved. Further, all four pieces of the beautiful granite shipped from India have been delivered. However upon uncrating the two columns, it was discovered that both columns were broken in transit. A reorder mandate has been issued for replacement. A new dedication date will need to be established and will be announced at a later date.
