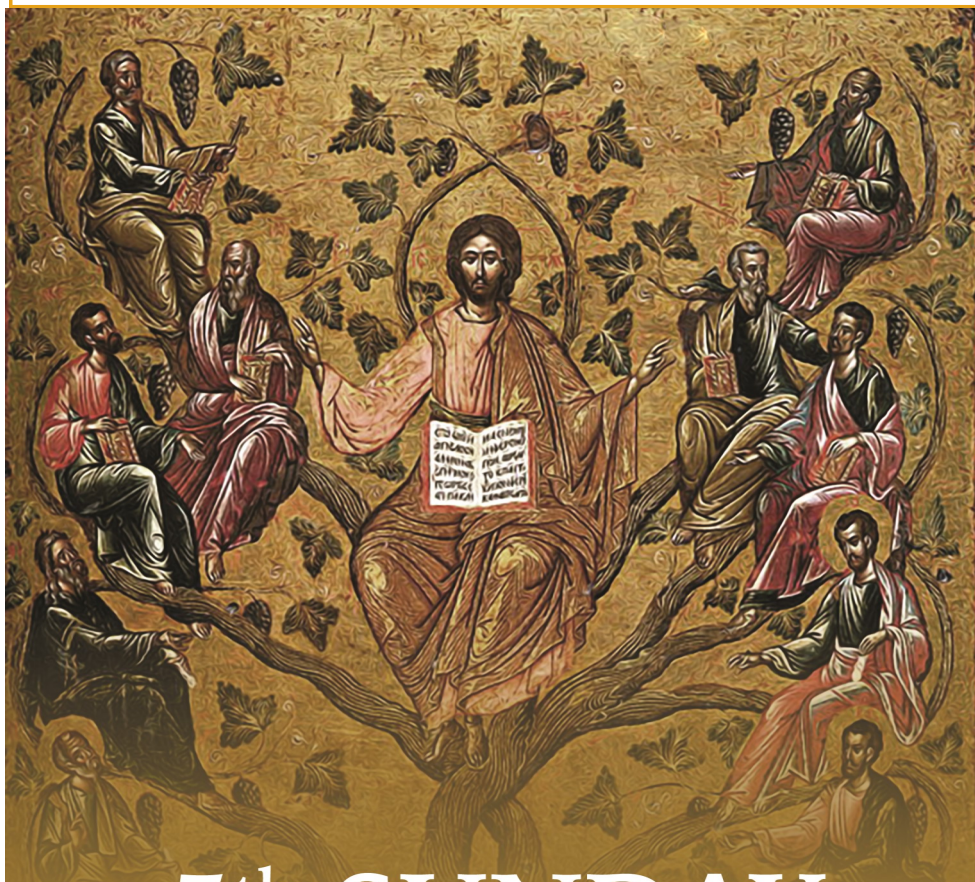

OLG public Mass re-opening guidelines

1. During the time of the Corona virus pandemic, Archbishop Naumann has given Catholics in the Archdiocese a dispensation from attending in person public Mass.
2. Anyone feeling uncomfortable coming back to public Mass knowing the risks involved should stay home, especially those in high risk groups such as people with serious underlying medical conditions & the elderly.
3. **The mask mandate for Shawnee county has expired. Parishioners are encouraged to wear a mask, but it will not be required. If you do not wear a mask, we ask that you maintain a 6 foot distance from other families. Thank you**
4. During consecration time, people are allowed to kneel.
5. The choir will only have an accompanist & a cantor.
6. People cannot congregate socializing before or after Mass per Archdiocese and CDC guidelines. Please go home immediately after Mass. The Church will be sanitized after mass to be ready for the next group.
7. **Holy Communion will be given only in the hand.**

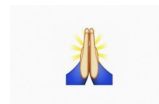
