The bishops urge our pastors, lay and religious faithful, and all people of good will to use this statement to help form their consciences; to teach those entrusted to their care; to contribute to civil and respectful public dialogue; and to shape political choices in the coming election in light of Catholic teaching.

The statement lifts up our dual heritage as both faithful Catholics and American citizens with rights and duties as participants in the civil order.

Requisitos Para Bautizos

1. Padres y Padrinos deben estar registrados y necesitamos una copia del certificado de nacimiento por el niño(a).
2. Padres y Padrinos deben tomar una clase pre-bautismal primero antes de apartar la fecha de bautismo.
3. Si los niños son mayores de 7 años tienen que tomar una clase especial.
4. Si los padres quieren que otro sacerdote bautice al niño, la familia debe comunicarse con ese sacerdote por su cuenta y luego comunicarse con la parroquia para programar la fecha.
5. Si los padrinos están en otra parroquia pueden tomar las clases en esa parroquia y traer una carta con sello enseñando que tomaron las clases en su parroquia.
6. Los Padrinos tienen que:
 - Tener 16 años o más
 - Ser bautizado en la iglesia Católica
 - Tener certificado de Confirmación (necesitamos una copia)
7. Los padrinos solo pueden ser un hombre y una mujer casados por la iglesia católica o solo un hombre soltero y/ o una sola mujer soltera.
8. Si los padrinos están casados, necesitaremos una copia del certificado de matrimonio en la iglesia Católica.
9. Se pide una donación de \$40.00 para la iglesia para ayudar con el sustento de la parroquia. Por favor cubra esta donación al apartar la fecha.

The parish food box has been moved to the main entrance of the church. **Please bring any non-perishable food for donation to those less fortunate in our community.** Canned goods only and please **NO** glass containers. The goal for our parish is 1,110 pounds of food to commemorate OLG

SHOE COLLECTION

The OLG Social Justice committee has partnered with Sole Reason to collect used footwear of **any type** as long as it's a matching pair and there are no holes in them. **A collection box has been set up inside the church to collect the used footwear through November 8th.**

Jerry Hudgins, founder and CEO of Sole Reason, has given away over 9,000 pairs of NEW sneakers since 2016 to needy kids in Topeka. One of the ways they do this is through their used sneaker program. When Sole Reason has collected several hundred pairs of shoes, Hudgins contacts a company out of Florida who will come to Topeka and pick up the shoes. Sole Reason receives a check based on the weight of the footwear, which Hudgins then purchases NEW sneakers for Topeka youth.

The Florida company cleans up and replaces the soles of the donated shoes and sends them to Third World countries. This allows parents in Third World countries to provide a small income to feed their families.

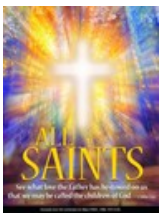
