- Tom Kim - no course history but #1 course fit. T5 last week, lost a stroke with the putter. Flaw is his length, which doesn't matter here. Best approach player in this field, 2nd strokes gained total. Price is warranted. 2nd highest ceiling and highest floor. Highest DK price ever but it's merited.
- Sungjae Im - not great course history, 56th and MC last two years.
- Hideki Matsuyama - won here last year. 21st last week. Lost on approach in 3 of last 4, but gained putting in 3 of 4 and ARG in all 4. Good spot to bet on him pulling it together.
- Jordan Spieth - volatile last week. Worst putting season of his career. But still in too class of this fiend and with east greens, he could get in the mix. Catch lightning in a bottle.
- Tom Hoge - best wedge player in the world. Next few weeks will be good spots. Lost 4 ARG last week which is an outlier. Gained 10.2 on approach. Insane.
- Russell Henley: Back to back 11th place finished here. Has high ceiling, but low floor.
- Brian Harman - good week last week, good course history.
- Taylor Montgomery: criminally underpriced. Best strikes gained total last 36 rounds. 7 fall starts, 6 top 15 finishes. 87<sup>th</sup> fantasy scoring percentile.
- Billy Horschel - dead last first round last week, but had a great weekend. Buy low on Billy Ho. 7th 2 years ago here, 36th last year.
- Keegan Bradley - good finishes here, 2 12th place finishes in last 3 years. Played well in the fall with a win at Zozo. In play.
- Corey Connors - last 36 rounds, has never gained at least 3 strokes - only guy in the \$9k range. Limited upside.
- KH Lee - T7 at TOC, 3<sup>rd</sup> at CJ Cup, great Presidents Cup, T5 at BMW. Flying under the radar.

- Cam Davis – 9<sup>th</sup>, 31<sup>st</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> here. Also feels criminally underpriced. Great presidents cup. Hasn't lost more than 1 stroke to the field since the Memorial last June.
- Keith Mitchell – course history guy – 4 top 25s in last 5 here. A bit volatile, hasn't quite put 4 rounds together.
- Adam Scott – In play this week.
- Si Woo Kim – not on him this week.
- Christiaan Bezuidenhout – not on him this week.
- Kurt Kitayama – Buy low.
- Alex Smalley – Great end to his fall swing – T11 Bermuda, T4 Houston, T5 RSM Classic. Gained 2.5 on approach and 3.3 in Houston and RSM. T2G sharp in both, 14 strokes gained total in those 8 rounds. Upside, some volatility.
- Hayden Buckley – high upside, elite skillset. Finished 12<sup>th</sup> here last year.
- Will Gordon – Great OTT in the last few starts, didn't miss a single cut in the fall swing. T3 at Mayakoba. Won on KFT 3 starts before the fall swing. 5 top 15s and a win in his last 12 events.
- Nick Hardy – Elite iron player.
- Adam Svensson – Didn't play great last week – 37<sup>th</sup> out of 39<sup>th</sup> and lost 8 strokes putting (outlier). This is a good course fit. 7<sup>th</sup> here last year. Buying low.
- Greyson Sigg – 82<sup>nd</sup> fantasy scoring percentile in fall swing. Scottie was 80<sup>th</sup> for reference.
- Ben Griffin – Ended fall swing in 71<sup>st</sup> fantasy scoring percentile. Scottie was 80<sup>th</sup> for reference.
- Stephan Jaeger – in play.
- Robby Shelton – coming off of 10<sup>th</sup> place finish, finished 25<sup>th</sup> here 2 years ago.

- Kevin Yu - ball-striking is incredible. Gained OTT in every measured event in the fall. Only lost strokes once on approach. Team no putt. Will he putt well enough this week to pay off his price tag?
- Andrew Putnam – not long but accurate, 22<sup>nd</sup> implied win, 35<sup>th</sup> in SG approach and 10<sup>th</sup> SG putting in last 24, positive course history.
- Matt Kuchar – 3<sup>rd</sup> in Rick's initial model. Bump for course history, putting and approach in last 24.

- Tom Kim – Not surprising he's the favorite. Perfect course for him. Will be extremely popular. Likes Sungjae more.
- Sungjae Im – Likes the ownership discount, could argue he should be favored over Tom. So good off the tee and putting has been great. Perfect course fit.
- Hideki Matsuyama – not himself, losing OTT and on approach, but gained strokes putting in 6 straight. Bizarre. Will not lean on him.

**SPENCER AGUIAR:**

- Tom Kim: Metrics are incredible. GIR and Bogey Avoidance rate are 3% better than the rest of the field. There will be regression at some point. But in play, 1-2 with Sungjae.
- Sungjae Im: Prefers him over Tom. Know what he is as a golfer. Take the \$ and ownership discount.
- Jordan Spieth: Like him this week for GPP. Accuracy OTT is an issue but low ownership for a guy with tangible win equity. Unique leverage with him.
- Hideki Matsuyama: Don’t know where he is. Last week was not his game – short game was good, lost OTT and APP. Can’t sustain success with his short game. Fade.
- Brian Harman: Books have him showing up as 3<sup>rd</sup> favorite, even over Spieth. Favorite over everyone in the \$9k range.



- Keegan Bradley: Going to play him. Bermuda putting is so atrocious, but willing to take a risk on ballstriking.
- Maverick McNealy: Would rather play him over Taylor Montgomery, mostly on ownership. Neutral rating.
- Taylor Montgomery: Metrics look really good, but feel like regression is coming, small sample size. At 11-12% avoid him, play Mav if you're looking for leverage.
- Si Woo Kim: Boom or bust, play him if sub-10%. TBD on ownership.

- Tom Hoge: Love him this week, surprised at ownership projections.
- Russell Henley: Fade at projected ownership.
- Corey Connors: Only downside is Bermuda putting but he gains strokes here every year. Ok with him, hate the ownership.
- Keegan Bradley: Bail based on bermuda putting...pay up for Billy Ho.
- Maverick McNealy: TBD on ownership.
