- 6. Maintain eFoil equipment in good working condition and report any issues to the Business Manager.
- 7. Assist with equipment setup, maintenance, and storage as required.
- 8. Provide outstanding customer service by addressing client inquiries, providing recommendations, and creating a positive atmosphere.
- 9. Foster a friendly and inclusive environment that encourages learning and skill development.
- 10. Stay up-to-date with industry trends, new technologies, and safety practices related to eFoiling.

- 3. Strong knowledge of water safety protocols and emergency procedures.
- 4. Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, with the ability to adapt teaching methods to different learning styles.
- 5. Current First Aid and CPR certifications.
- 6. Current Bronze Medallion Qualification is highly desirable.
- 7. A friendly, patient, and encouraging demeanour.
- 8. Physical fitness and the ability to demonstrate proper eFoil techniques.
- 9. Flexibility to work weekends and holidays based on demand.
