### Who Is This Program For?

- You were born as or identify as male
- 18 years of age or older
- Currently experiencing houselessness or are at immediate risk of houselessness. Prioritizes men with high needs and high risk, such as leaving incarceration, shelters or chronic houselessness
- Have a goal towards obtaining permanent housing
- Ready and willing to work on personal housing and healing goals

### How Do I Get Into the Program?

- Start by connecting with a local housing or support agency, such as shelters, outreach workers, Brandon Friendship Centre, BNRC or Corrections [Federal & Provincial]
- Complete a Standard Housing Needs Assessment with one of the above supports and your name will be added to the community's 'By-Name List'.

A community team regularly reviews each individual's needs along with available space, matches and refers individuals to openings, which can include this Program.

*\*\*Units will go to people with the greatest need and highest risk, rather than those who sign up first.\*\**

### How Long Can I Stay in the Program?

- Time-limited but flexible.
- Short term (approx. 3 months) to Long term (approx. 1 year) while working on a plan with your case manager regarding permanent housing in the community.
