

Dana has been selling his automotive art at B-J for 23 years and it's one of his most important shows. So on January 17, Dana and I headed west to Scottsdale with a van FULL of his wonderful artwork. When we finally reached WestWorld we set up his display in the vendors Exhibition Hall. We had to have everything in place before the event officially began on Thursday January 20th. This gave us plenty of time to explore the venue, the cars and the automobilia.

There were over 1900 auction cars and 6000 bidders . The exhibit hall housed not only artwork and automotive accessories for sale but also mattresses, hot tubs and even a helicopter. I had ample time to explore the cars for sale. There were classics like a 1939 Mercedes 540K cabriolet, exotics like Lamborghinis and Ferraris, muscle cars like Superbirds and Boss 429s and there were CORVETTES and more CORVETTES.

Many Vettes had been transformed into restomods. The engineering and craftsmanship is nearly indescribable. But there were also a lot of restored originals, many which had attained the NCRS Top Flight and even the Duntov awards. Among my favorites was a 1965 Big Tank coupe, a 1953 Vette and a 1958 Charcoal Fuelie. There was even a 1961 Fawn Beige roadster that is a twin to my own car.



What is a Sportsman Award? The Sportsman award encourages members to drive their corvette to judging events. The award is used to recognize a member who actively attends and participates in local Chapter, Regional and National meets. The award is presented by a Chapter officer at the event. It's a great way to attend an event and enjoy driving your car.

There are some requirements for the award. You must be a NCRS member. You must drive and own a 1953 thru 2023 Corvette. At the event, park your car in the parking area for the Sportsman cars or on the judging field. The car is not judged. The car must remain in this area during the event. Like in any judging event you must have proof of liability insurance and a current registration.


Points are earned at each event you attend. The car earns 2 for Chapter, 3 for Regional and 5 for National. If you drive your car to several events, you can earn a Sportsman plaque. This is after you earn 20 points which includes 2 Regionals within a 3-year period. The Sportsman plaque is awarded by the National to be presented at a local chapter.
