

Let's Get Technical

Quick Review of 1953-1960 Gas Caps, by Tom Dingman (4889), Part 1. – April 21, 2024


This eBay offering has an "EATON LOGO STAMP" on the topside. The eBay Seller is asking \$299. The Seller admits: "HAVE NOT SEEN THIS IN THE MANUALS", but... "It fits Corvettes".

Would you buy this for your early Corvette?



For 1953-1956, and early 1957, NCRS does indeed bless a <u>vented gas cap made by Eaton</u>. However, a correct version (for these years) does NOT have a "turn bar" on the top. See the 1953-1955 NCRS TIM&JG is dated 2023, 7th ed. (TIM&JG stands for Technical Information Manual and Judging Guide.) Watch below for photos from the 1956-1857 TIM&JG; same cap design.






Let's Get Technical (continued)


1956-1957 Corvette Gas Caps – NCRS says "Two Different ones".

First was for 1956, from Eaton and VENTED, just like '53-'55 caps; Also used in early 1957.

The 1956-1957 TIM&JG has a better photo. Look below for the Eaton logo, inside the cap. Sure looks like the '53-'55 cap, does it not?



The 1957 later cap; NCRS says_after VIN 1900; Not Vented.



Let's Get Technical (continued)

The use of this '57 non-vented cap continued into early 1958. According to NCRS, five different non vented caps were used from 1958-1962. Suppliers included Eaton, Stant and more. One was from the Fuller Emerson Co. It is stamped with "F" and "E", for the two names; Not Full and Empty... Both the Stant and the Fuller Emerson versions are today available as reproductions. The Stant version is a pretty good "repop". It is pictured below. A center rivet head is stamped "S" for Stant, like the originals. Photos here from Corvette Central:




Below is the backside of the STANT reproduction. **I do not know why the color is red**. If you know, please text, or call me at (810) 338 0307.

Here below is a Fuller Emerson original.




Compare the Fuller Emerson above with a photo of the reproduction below. The photo below was copied from the Corvette Central website, in April of 2024.



I see two bumps in the center indentation of the original Fuller Emerson Cap. I might buy the repro. That way I can see if they (the little bumps) are simply missing in the CC photo, or missing on the cap.

1962 Corvettes with the 24-gallon fuel tank came with a very special chrome plated cap. More on that in a later article.

Look at the two photos above and note the various items that were factory over sprayed on this original Corvette. (This photo Credit: 1958-1960 CORVETTE RESTORATION HAND-BOOK, by Bob Baird, PhD and Tom Howey, MD.)

Let's Get Technical (continued)

I looked at my November 1981 (11-81) parts book and found (by that time) GM was selling a single <u>vented cap</u> for all 1953-1962 Corvettes. In group number 3.028 that replacement was listed first. The assigned number was 3814436. If you have one, I'd like a photo or the cap.

In the same parts book, I found the special (or the replacement) chrome plated cap for the Corvettes with a 24-gallon tank. It's "no longer serviced" part number was 3814958. Again, this was the 11-81 parts book. If you have one, and it is different from the original chrome plated version, I'd like a photo. I believe it was used on other vehicles, including Chevrolet pick-up trucks.
