General Assembly recognizes Preston

June 17, 2004

COLUMBIA, SC – On June 1, 2004 the South Carolina General Assembly approved House Resolution # 5399 which recognizes Anderson County Administrator Joey R. Preston.

The resolution names Mr. Preston “one of the most innovative and effective local government officials in South Carolina.” It also lists the professional awards earned by him and Anderson County (under his leadership), along with several civic accomplishments.

The resolution closes with the following words:

“Whereas, the members of the General Assembly, by this resolution, would like to recognize this truly outstanding county administrator for all he has accomplished for Anderson County and the other communities he has served and for his contributions in many other capacities to his community, State, and nation. Now, therefore,

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

That the members of the General Assembly commend Mr. Joey R. Preston, Anderson County Administrator, for his outstanding success as a county administrator and for being one of the most innovative and effective local government officials in South Carolina.”
