A Message from our Pastor

Dear Parish Family,

This year, the Feast of the Presentation of Our Lord Jesus in the Temple falls on a Sunday. I am so happy because this year in the context of our Sunday celebration, we can all explore this great mystery, and relish the truth and light of Jesus coming to meet His people!

The Gospel tells us that Mary and Joseph bring Jesus to the Temple to present Him to the Most High God, as was the custom of Jewish Law. Also, because Jesus was considered a "first born son," St. Joseph had to offer the sacrifice of two turtledoves. This was considered a "poor man's offering" and so we know the Holy Family were living in humble circumstances. Nonetheless, they were faithful to their religion and its laws.

Then something unexpected and wonderful happens. The priest, Simeon, and the prophetess, Anna, both recognize the Infant Jesus as the Messiah, the one who has come to meet His people and save them. This is a teaching so that we can recognize the presence of Jesus in the midst of this world, the one who has come to heal and save us from our hateful ways. Jesus is described by the priest Simeon as "the light that will enlighten the nations." That is why on this day, throughout the whole church, we bless all the candles we will use at the altar and tabernacle. The lights of the altar remind us to follow Jesus the light with our whole lives.

Much of our world turns away from the light of Christ because the light reveals the things that need to change. The light of Christ that shines in the Gospel and in the Sacraments of the Church often points out to us the faults and failures of our own lives, and if we are unwilling to change, that light can make us feel uncomfortable. But, if the light is true and holy, what better choice is there than to change to be better?

There are other lights in this world that burn brightly for us. The light that we see in the consecrated religious, our nuns and monks, brothers and sisters who have consecrated their lives to Christ and seek to be like Him – poor, chaste, and obedient. We celebrate their commitment on this day, and we pray for many more vocations to the religious life from among our young people – Let your light shine brightly in the midst of the Church! Do not fear to serve Jesus with your whole life!






