

A Message from our Pastor

Dear Parish Family,

The Gospel of St. Luke this Sunday presents us with a familiar story – The Good Samaritan. Jesus gives us this powerful image in order to respond to an important question: Who is my neighbor? This same question is asked in Matthew and in Mark, but in Luke we get the dramatic illustration of what it means to "love your neighbor as yourself."

In Catholic Social Teaching, we use an important word that is not often heard in daily conversation: SOLIDARITY. The virtue of solidarity at its basic level means to understand that the good of the other person cannot be separated from my own good. SOLIDARITY means that in order to love ourselves, we cannot ever cease loving others. If we do cease loving others, it means that we have begun to love ourselves less, and we are going down a path that can actually lead to self-destruction.

The opposite of solidarity in many ways is indifference. Often, we have the idea that another person's problems are simply their own and have nothing to do with us, and are not our responsibility. But that idea is always a lie. The suffering of another person, made in God's image and likeness, affects each one of us in this world. Those people so numbed by violence and hatred who cannot feel and understand the suffering of another have listened to the lie of the evil one.

Jesus frees us from that evil and gives us a new way to live in communion. Jesus gives us a way to love fully allowing compassion and tenderness to move our hearts to act in a way that manifests our human dignity and strengthens the bonds of human community. That is the solidarity that communities need, working together to heal and bind up wounds. Christ powerfully calls His disciples to work together in SOLIDARITY for the kingdom, healing and loving one another until the Lord comes to find us faithfully at His work.
