A Message from our Pastor

Dear Parish Family,

None of us has any personal experience of the journey of the soul after the moment of death. We do know a lot about that journey from Scripture and Sacred Tradition, though. We know that the journey of the soul, like all journeys or pilgrimages, is given its essential character by the destination. The soul on its journey to heaven, like anyone on any journey, is changed and challenged by the trip. Journeys that are made after a lot of good preparation are easier journeys, and journeys undertaken when a person is filled with confusion and doubt are harder journeys. If we embrace the journey, however, it becomes a kind of pilgrimage through which we become better on our way, and we reach the desired destination (in this case, heaven) in a better condition than when we left.

This is a way to understand the journey of the faithful departed to heaven. We who are still here on earth are obliged in faith to accompany the holy souls on their journey to the Father's house with our prayers and Masses. It is through prayer and the Eucharist that we are all found together in Holy Communion, the Church on Earth, the Church on the Journey, and the Church in Heaven. All journeys we make are better if we have a person to keep us company on the way, and this is what we do on All Soul's Day in a special way. We keep company with the souls of our loved ones who have gone before us, and that company is real for those who believe in eternal life.

Because we live in a place dominated by reform Christianity which denies the natural and necessary connection in prayer between the living and the dead, we often are faced with challenges as to why we pray for souls. The answer is simple: because the Christian soul lives forever, and prayer transcends time and space, we remain connected in a beautiful language of love, and those of us still here on earth owe it to the Holy Souls to be good company, faithful companions on the way, and mindful of the condition of our own souls, which one day will make that powerful journey to the Father's House.
