A Message from our Pastor

Dear Parish Family,

“They left everything and followed Him...” This story of the calling of the first disciples is made up of four small scenes. In the first scene, we are presented with two characters: on one side we see Jesus, proclaiming the Good News to a crowd that has come to search Him out, and on the other side, a group of laborers, weary and discouraged by the difficulties and monotony of their existence. In the second scene, these two groups come together as Jesus climbs into Peter’s boat, which is situated among the boats of all the weary fishermen. Here we see the first point of contact.

Then in the third scene, the relationship between the fishermen and Jesus grows. Jesus, with the power of His word, proposes the great risk of working with the virtue of hope. St. Peter takes the risk that Jesus proposes, and he is astounded by the marvelous and unexpected results. Then in the fourth and final scene, we find focus on the classic words related to vocation in Christ: “to leave and to follow.” It is only in St. Luke’s Gospel where we find the radical detail of what is required by Christ, “They left **everything.**”

So many people in the world find themselves discouraged and complaining about things they feel they cannot change. Be it in the world of politics, in the world of self-improvement, or be it in the context of human relationships, there are moments when we feel discouraged and without Hope. It is precisely in these moments when Jesus proposes to us to look to Him to let him renew our hope with His grace. Jesus renews us by including us in His work. In the work of the Kingdom, which is always transformative because it takes us out of ourselves and brings us into a greater world of discipleship and belonging.

Those weary fisherman, especially St. Peter, were transformed by the Good News preached to them and the hope restored in them by Christ. May we be renewed and restored by our encounter with Christ in the Eucharist and come to leave behind all our failures and disappointments to follow Him as true disciples!

Summer Softball Sign-ups!

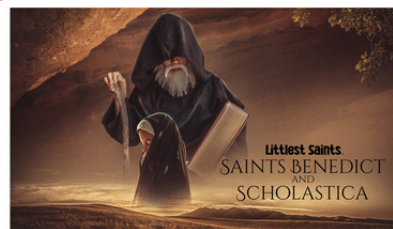
