
#### Parish Mission Statement

# A Message from our Pastor

Dear Parish Family,

Over the past few weeks, we have been privileged to witness the powerful events surrounding the death of His Holiness, Pope Francis and the election of His Holiness, Pope Leo XIV. Of course, in our current day, the media coverage of these events has been intense, as well as the production of endless snippets of social media, Instagram reels, TikTok's, etc. many of which offer often pointless and sometimes demeaning concepts about the papacy and the person of Pope Leo. It is by no accident, then, that in his first address to college of cardinals who elected him the Holy Spirit, Pope Leo spoke of the Church's role in safeguarding essential human dignity in the face of a "new industrial revolution" regarding artificial intelligence.

The Holy Father spoke of what the scriptures teach us – scriptures we hear powerfully this Sunday – that renewal in the Church and in the world is always in reference to the Truth of Christ. Sadly, so many Christians have been led astray by advocating for "issues" rather than advocating for the Christ. Many commentators have speculated on what Pope Leo's "views" might be. Undue focus on issues and views is to ignore the reason that the Pope is the successor to St. Peter – to be the sign of unity in the Church pointing to the eternal Truth of Christ. If we keep our vision on Christ, understanding the Love of God sent into the world in the person of His Divine Son, we will have the principles to respond to any situation or "issue" that can arise in this world.

It is not the purpose of religion to address issues, it is the purpose of religion to proclaim the Good News of Christ, to live that truth authentically in our lives, and to worship the One True God in the way He has asked – In the Holy Communion of mind, body, and spirit. Renewal in the Truth of Christ is the sacred principle that gives continuity in the life of the Church – not being merely frozen in some historical time period or cultural movement. Jesus tells us not to be troubled or afraid, and then He promises us His Divine Presence. It is that Eucharistic presence that continues to guide us in every aspect of our lives, proclaiming authentically the Good News of Christ's love in this world, and His desire for us to be with Him in eternity.
