A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR



Dear Parish Family,

This Fourth Sunday of Advent focuses on the gift of Peace. Peace is a thing that many desire, but often we are confused as to what peace really means. In our common speech, peace usually means the absence of conflict. For the Christian, however, peace has a much deeper meaning.

One of the pre-requisites for true peace is obedience. It is often said, "In obedience there is peace." This type of obedience does not mean simply saying "yes" to keep the peace, but rather it is an active type of obedience, looking for ways in which we can re-

spond positively to God's will for us. We will always encounter situations of conflict and we will always come upon things that disturb us and shake our calm. Peace, however, consists in how we respond to these moments, seeking to do God's will.

Another key ingredient in true peace is mercy. The gift of pardon and love, looking for the best in the other is a powerful thing. As humans, we are so given to "holding our ground" when conflicts arise, that we forget to give space for the power of mercy to take hold.

Finally, peace comes from an understanding that no matter what happens in this world - God is in charge - and He is at work to bring all things to the good despite the fact that we constantly fail in our attempts to serve Him and to love others as we ought.

As Christmas approaches, our parish community can focus on the mystery of the Eucharist and be a community dedicated to peace in our world. I think that with our Eucharistic faith and our fervent prayer lives. we can truly bring the gift of peace to our community and to the world!
